

Summary and Highlights

Puducherry Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of 30 newly elected MLAs in the Puducherry 2016 Assembly Elections.

Criminal background

- **MLAs with criminal cases:** Out of all the **30** MLAs analysed, **11 (37%)** MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of 30 MLAs analysed during **Puducherry Assembly elections in 2011**, **10 (33%)** MLAs had **declared criminal cases** against themselves.
- **MLAs with serious criminal cases:** **4 (13%)** MLAs have declared serious criminal cases including cases related to **murder, attempt to murder, theft, bribery** etc. Out of **30** MLAs analysed during **Puducherry Assembly elections in 2011**, **3 (10%)** MLAs had **declared serious criminal cases** against themselves.




Figure: Comparison of MLAs with declared criminal cases in 2011 and 2016

- **MLAs with cases related to murder and attempt to murder:** **1** MLA namely **R.K.R.Anantharaman** of **INC** from **Manavely** constituency has declared **1** charge related to **Murder** and **1** charge related to **Attempt to Murder** in his affidavit.
- **Party wise MLAs with criminal cases:** **5 (33%)** out of 15 MLAs from **INC**, **3 (38%)** out of 8 MLAs from **All India N.R. Congress**, **2 (100%)** out of 2 MLAs from **DMK**, **1 (25%)** out of 4 MLAs from **AIADMK** have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

- **Party wise MLAs with serious criminal cases:** 3 (20%) out of 15 MLAs from INC, 1 (13%) out of 8 MLAs from All India N.R. Congress have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.




Figure: Party wise number of MLAs with declared criminal cases




Figure: Share of wealth among MLAs




Figure: Comparison of crorepati MLAs in 2011 & 2016

- **Party wise crorepati MLAs:** 13 (87%) out of 15 MLAs from INC, 6 (75%) out of 8 MLAs from All India N.R. Congress, 3 (75%) out of 4 MLAs from AIADMK, 2 (100%) out of 2 MLAs from DMK and 1 (100%) Independent MLA have declared assets valued more than Rs 1 crore.




Figure: Party wise number of crorepati MLAs

- **Average assets:** The average of assets per MLA who won in the Puducherry 2016 assembly elections is **Rs. 13.45 crores**, whereas the average asset for each candidate who contested in the 2016 assembly elections is **Rs 2.48 crores**. In 2011, the average assets per 30 MLAs analyzed was **Rs 4.43 crores**.




Figure: Comparative analysis of average assets of MLAs and contesting candidates in 2011 & 2016

- **Party wise average assets:** Among major parties, the average assets per MLA for **15 INC MLAs** analysed is **Rs 9.89 crores**, **8 All India N.R. Congress** MLAs have average assets of **Rs 23.53 crores**, **4 AIADMK** MLAs have average assets worth of **Rs.5.69 crores** and **2 DMK** MLAs have average assets of **Rs. 21.48 crores**.

Comparative analysis of assets of re-elected MLAs

- **Number of re-elected MLAs:** Number of re-elected MLAs analysed in the assembly elections of 2016 is **10**.
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2011:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2011 were valued at **Rs 7.99 crores**.
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2016:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2016 are valued at **Rs 22.64 crores**.
- **Average growth in assets of re-elected MLAs from 2011 to 2016:** The growth in average assets of re-elected MLAs is **Rs 14.64 crores** i.e. by **183%**.

- **Education Details of MLAs:** 15 (50%) MLAs have declared their education qualifications to be between 5th pass and 12th pass, while 13 (43%) MLAs have declared their educational qualification to be of graduate or above and 1 MLA has declared to be an illiterate.
- **Age details of MLAs:** 15 (50%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 25 and 50 years while 15 (50%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 51 and 70 years.
- **Gender details of MLAs:** Out of the total 30 MLAs, 4 (13%) MLAs are women. There were no women MLAs in the previous Legislative Assembly of the Puducherry.


