

## Summary and Highlights

Uttarakhand Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 70 newly elected MLAs in the Uttarakhand 2017 Assembly Elections.



### Final Party Positions in 2017 Uttarakhand Assembly Elections

## Criminal background

- **MLAs with criminal cases:** Out of the **70** MLAs analysed, **22(31%)** MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of 70 MLAs analysed during **Uttarkhand Assembly elections in 2012**, **19 (27%)** MLAs had **declared criminal cases** against themselves.
- **MLAs with serious criminal cases:** **14(20%)** MLAs have declared serious criminal cases including cases related to **murder, attempt to murder, dacoity, robbery** etc. Out of **70** MLAs analysed during **Uttarakhand Assembly elections in 2012**, **5 (7%)** MLAs had **declared serious criminal cases** against themselves.




Figure: Comparison of MLAs with declared criminal cases in 2012 and 2017

### Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

- MLAs with cases related to murder and attempt to murder:** 2 MLAs have declared cases related to **murder and attempt to murder**.
- Party wise MLAs with criminal cases:** 17(30%) out of 57 MLAs from **BJP**, 4 (36%) out of 11 MLAs from **INC**, and 1(50%) out of 2 **Independent** MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- Party wise MLAs with serious criminal cases:** 10(18%) out of 57 MLAs from **BJP**, 3(27%) out of 11 MLAs from **INC** and 1 (50%) out of 2 Independent MLAs have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.





Figure: Party wise number of MLAs with declared criminal cases





- **Partywise crorepati MLAs:** 40 (70%) out of 57 MLAs from **BJP**, 10 (91%) out of 11 MLAs from **INC**, and 1 (50%) out of 2 **Independent** MLAs have declared assets valued more than **Rs 1 crore**.



- **Average assets:** The average of assets per MLA who won in the Uttarakhand 2017 assembly elections is **Rs. 4.11 crores**, In 2012, the average assets MLAs analyzed was **Rs 1.86 crores**.
- **Party wise average assets:** The average assets per MLA for **57 BJP** MLAs analysed is **Rs 4.09 crores**, **11 INC** MLAs have average assets of **Rs 4.70 crores** and **2 Independent** MLAs have average assets of **Rs. 1.40 crores**.
- **MLAs with high liabilities:** 6 MLAs have declared liabilities of **Rs 1 crore** and above, and the details of the top 3 MLAs are as follows:

- **Number of re-elected MLAs:** Number of re-elected MLAs analysed in the assembly elections of 2017 is 32
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2012:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2012 was Rs. Rs 2.37 crores
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2017:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2017 is Rs 3.51 crores
- **Average growth in assets of re-elected MLAs from 2012 to 2017:** The growth in average assets of re-elected MLAs is Rs 1.13 crores i.e. by **48%**.








