59 newly elected MLAs in Jharkhand (i.e 73%) have pending criminal cases against them according to their self sworn affidavits

Out of these 59 MLAs, 26, i.e. 32% have pending criminal cases of serious nature, like Murder, Attempt to Murder, Kidnapping, Theft etc.

14 related to attempt to murder, 4 cases related to murder, 14 cases related to theft, etc. among pending serious cases against the newly elected MLAs

More than 26% assembly crorepati in Jharkhand

Ranchi, December 26, 2009: Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations, has been working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India.

National Election Watch conducted election watches during Jharkhand Assembly Election 2009. The pre-election reports were shared with the media. The reports included looking at the affidavits and disseminating information based on criminal, financial and other background information.

Now the election results are announced for the Jharkhand assembly election 2009, National Election Watch and its partner have analyzed the affidavits of all the elected representatives and have come out with this information.

The total no of contestants were 1491 for 81 seats of Jharkhand assembly election 2009. NEW has analyzed 1018 affidavits of candidates contesting for Jharkhand Assembly election 2009.

MLAs with Criminal background: Out of 329 candidates with pending criminal cases who contested in these elections, a total of 59 won. Newly elected MLAs have declared that they have pending criminal cases of such heinous crimes as murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping or abducting in order to murder, theft, illegal payments in connection with election etc. There are 4 cases related to murder, 14 cases of attempt to murder, 14 cases of theft and several others pending against the newly elected MLAs of Jharkhand assembly. Party wise breakup is given below:

Comparison with last assembly: The 2005 Jharkhand assembly had only 31 MLAs with pending criminal records. The number of MLAs with pending criminal records in the new assembly is 59, which is 73 % of the assembly.

Comparison with Last assembly: The 2004 Jharkhand Assembly had only 2 crorepati MLAs. This assembly shows a huge increase in the number of crorepati MLAs from 2% to 26%.

Average Assets of MLAs:

The average assets of MLAs are well in excess of 91 Lac. Party wise details are given below:

The average assets of MLAs in 2005 were only 25Lacs. The new average of 91 lacs shows a huge increase of 262% in the average assets of the MLAs.

Chances of winning based on assets:

The analysis also shows that if you have money, your chances of winning elections are much higher. NEW looks at the contesting candidates and their chances of success and have found that the more money you have, better are your chances of being elected.

As can be seen from the table above, 35% of candidates, who had declared their asset more than 2 Cr, got elected to Jharkhand Assembly 2009. While only 2% of candidates who had declared low assets, i.e. less than 10 lakhs, got elected to Jharkhand assembly 2009.
