West Bengal Legislative Assembly: Bhabanipur Bye -Elections 30 September, 2021 Criminal Background, Financial, Education, Gender and other details of Candidates

Association for Democratic Reforms and West Bengal Election Watch have analyzed self-sworn affidavits of all **12 candidates** contesting in West Bengal Assembly Bye-election to be held in 1 constituency namely **Bhabanipur on 30th September, 2021**.

- There are **2 (17%)** candidates who have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of these, 1 has declared serious criminal cases against himself.
- **2(17%)** candidates are crorepati.
- The average assets per candidate contesting in the bye election from **Bhabanipur** constituency is **Rs. 67.36 Lacs**.
- There are 3 candidates who have declared liabilities.
- Out of 12 candidates, **5** are women.
