Summary and Highlights

Maharashtra Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of **16 candidates** who are contesting for the **8 seats** in the **Maharashtra Legislative Council Biennial Elections of 2015**, from Local Authorities Constituencies.

Criminal Background

- **Candidates with Criminal Cases:** Out of the **16** candidates analysed, **12 (75%)** candidates have declared criminal cases against them.
- **Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:** Out of the **16** candidates, **2 (13%)** candidates have declared serious criminal cases.
- **Party wise Candidates with Criminal Cases:**
3 (100%) out of **3** candidates analysed from **INC**,
3 (100%) out of **3** candidates analysed from **NCP**,
2 (100%) out of **2** candidates analysed from **BJP**
and **2 (67%)** out of **3** candidates analysed from **Shiv Sena** have declared **criminal cases** against themselves in their affidavits.
- **Party wise Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:** **1 (33%)** out of 3 candidates analysed from **INC** and **1 (33%)** out of 3 candidates analysed from **NCP** have declared **serious criminal cases** against themselves in their affidavits.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

Financial Background

- **Crorepati Candidates:** Out of the 16 candidates analysed, **15 (94%)** are crorepatis.
- **High Asset Candidates:** Out of 16 candidates analysed, **10** candidates declared assets worth more than Rs. 10 crores. **1 candidate has declared assets worth more than Rs 100 crores.** The details of the top five candidates with high assets are:-

- **Party-wise Crorepati Candidates:** **3 (100%)** out of **3** candidates analysed from **NCP**, **3 (100%)** out of **3** candidates analysed from **Shiv Sena**, **3 (100%)** out of **3** candidates analysed from **INC** and **1 (50%)** out of **2** candidates analysed from **BJP** are crorepatis. It is also interesting that all **5 (100%)** out of **5 Independents** are also crorepatis.

- **Party-wise Average Assets:** Among major parties, the average assets per candidate for **3** analysed **INC** candidates is **Rs 65.64 crores**, **3** analysed **NCP** candidates have average assets of **Rs.41.05 crores**, **3** analysed **Shiv Sena** candidates have average assets of **Rs. 8.60 crores** and **2** analysed **BJP** candidates have average assets of **Rs. 1.91 crores.**


