Maharashtra Election Watch* Lok Sabha elections 2009

Lok Sabha 2009 elections were held in three phases in Maharashtra from April 16, 2009 to April 30, 2009. This chapter includes the analysis of voting trend, criminalization, money power, gender etc in these elections. Information provided by ECI and details from the affidavits filed by contesting candidates have been used for above analysis.

Growth of political parties

In Lok Sabha 2004, 39 parties contested which rose to 67 in Lok Sabha 2009 elections. This reflects a rise of 72 % in the number of parties from Lok Sabha 2004 Elections to Lok Sabha 2009 Elections.

Growth in number of candidates

819 candidates contested Lok Sabha 2009 elections from Maharashtra as compared to 412 candidates in Lok Sabha 2004. There was a jump of 99% in number of candidates contesting in 2009.

Executive summary for candidates and MPs

Summary for candidates

- Affidavits of 808 candidates out of 819 contesting Lok Sabha 2009 elections were analyzed by Maharashtra Election Watch (MEW)*.
- Out of these 808 candidates, 146 candidates or 18% declared pending criminal cases against them. SHS had 15 out of 22 (68%) candidates with pending criminal cases, BJP had 13 out of 25 (52%) candidates with pending criminal cases, NCP had 9 out of 21 (43%) candidates and INC had 10 out of 25 (40%) candidates with pending criminal cases.
- Out of these 146 candidates with pending criminal cases, 63 had pending serious criminal cases like murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, robbery, extortion etc. BJP had 6, SHS- 5, NCP -4 and INC -1 candidate with pending serious criminal cases.
- There were 93 candidates of four main parties (INC, BJP, SHS & NCP) and out of these 93 candidates 47 (51%) had pending criminal cases against them. Comparing this to Lok Sabha 2004 elections, there were 90 candidates of four major parties- INC, BJP, SHS & NCP. Out of these 90 candidates of four major political parties 38 (42%) had pending criminal cases against them.
- There were 169 IPC charges of heinous nature on the candidates which included murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, extortion, etc.
- There were total 26 Red Alert constituencies where 3 or more contesting candidates had pending criminal cases. Beed, Chandrapur and Bhiwandi had 7 candidates each with pending criminal cases.
- A total of 138 candidates out of 808 i.e. 17% were crorepatis.

- A total of 45 candidates declared zero assets.
- A total of 136 candidates declared liabilities above 5 lakhs.
- Among major parties, the average asset per candidate for NCP was Rs. 10 crores, for INC was Rs 6 crores, for BJP
 was Rs. 4 crores and for SHS & MNS was Rs. 3 crores each.
- 57.3% of candidates (463 of 808) had not furnished PAN card details.
- Number of women candidates was just 55 (7%) as compared to 764 of men (93%).
- More than 50% candidates (405 of 808) were graduates & above.
- None of the parties managed to get votes anywhere near 50%. The highest votes polled were approx 20% by INC which was about 10% of the total registered voters. NCP managed 19% of the votes, BJP 18% and SHS 17%.

Summary for MPs

- Of the 20 candidates with the most serious criminal charges against them, only 2 won and the remaining 18 were rejected by the voters.
- Out of 48 MPs, 26 (54.17%) have pending criminal cases against them. In Lok Sabha 2004, 20 (41.67%) had pending criminal cases against them.
- Out of these 26 MPs with pending criminal cases, there are pending serious criminal cases against 10 MPs. Contrasting this with Lok Sabha 2004, 2 MPs had serious pending criminal cases.
- MPs with pending criminal cases have increased from 2 in Lok Sabha 2004 to 10 in Lok Sabha 2009. The number of total criminal cases against MPs has increased from 64 in Lok Sabha 2004 to 127 in Lok Sabha 2009. Similarly the number of total serious IPC sections against MPs has increased from 4 in 2004 to 20 in 2009.
- The number of crorepati MPs has increased from 20 in Lok Sabha 2004 to 38 in Lok Sabha 2009.
- Among major parties, the average asset per MP for NCP was Rs. 21 crores, for INC was Rs 8 crores, for BJP was Rs. 4 crores and for SHS was Rs. 3 crores each.
- Average asset for a MP from Maharashtra was Rs 8.07 crores.
- Out of 48 MPs, 3 had not declared their PAN details.
- Out of 55 women candidates, only 3 managed to win. Hence only 6% of MPs from Maharashtra in current Lok Sabha are women.

Voting and winning trend

The % of votes polled by major parties


The % of votes polled by four major parties clearly shows that none of the parties got anywhere close to the 50% mark. Total voting in the state was only 51%. INC managed approx 20 % of the votes cast and only 10% of the registered voters. SHS managed just 17% votes cast and 9% registered voters. The total electorate in Maharashtra was 72,928,907 and the total votes cast were 36,991,311.

Figure: Per cent of votes cast in Maharashtra- party wise




Candidates vs MPs

Analysis based on pending criminal cases

Pending criminal cases- analysis for candidates

Total 808 affidavits were analyzed by Maharashtra Election Watch (MEW) for Lok Sabha 2009 elections. Out of these 808 candidates, 146 candidates or 18% declared pending criminal cases against them. Out of these 146 candidates with pending criminal cases, 63 had pending serious criminal cases like murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, robbery, extortion etc.


Party wise break up for candidates with pending criminal cases

A total of 146 candidates contesting elections from Maharashtra had pending criminal cases against them. Out of 22 candidates of SHS, 15 (68%) had pending criminal cases. 13 out of 25 candidates from BJP (52%) had pending criminal cases. 43% of declared candidates of NCP and 40% of declared candidates of INC had pending criminal cases against them.

Party wise comparison of pending criminal cases on candidates in Lok Sabha 2004 & Lok Sabha 2009

A comparison between 2009 & 2004 Lok Sabha elections of candidates from four major parties and with pending criminal cases shows an interesting trend. For all 4 parties- INC, SHS, BJP & NCP the number of candidates with pending criminal cases has increased in 2009 elections as compared to 2004 elections.

Pending criminal cases- analysis for MPs


Out of 48 MPs from Maharashtra in Lok Sabha 2009, 26 MPs have pending criminal cases against them. Out of these 26 MPs, there are pending serious criminal cases against 10 MPs. Contrasting this with Lok Sabha 2004, only 2 MPs had serious pending criminal cases.

Given below is a current analysis for MPs with pending criminal charges elected from Maharashtra. The presence of MPs with pending criminal cases from Maharashtra in Lok Sabha has increased by 30%.

Figure: Comparison Lok Sabha 2004 & Lok Sabha 2009- MPs with pending criminal cases





Party wise break up for MPs with serious pending criminal cases

There are several cases of violent crimes like murder, attempt to murder, theft, extortion, robbery etc pending against MPs from Maharashtra. The chart below gives summary of all serious violent offences related to murder, kidnapping, extortion, theft, robbery and dacoity. As can be seen MPs of NCP have 9 pending serious criminal IPC counts against them as compared to 5 of SHS, 4 of BJP and 2 of INC.

Tainted constituency analysis

There were 27 tainted constituencies where at least one tainted candidate (candidate having pending criminal cases) given ticket by a party contested. For the analysis given below only party candidates and candidates having serious criminal cases pending against them were considered.

In constituencies with fewer candidates with pending criminal cases, voters have chosen clean MPs. But as the number of candidates with pending criminal cases increases, voters have limited choice and had to choose candidates with pending criminal cases.

In case of just a single tainted candidate, the voters chose clean MPs 47% of the time but all constituencies with 3 or more tainted candidates had tainted MPs.



Out of affidavits analyzed for 808 candidates who contested in Lok Sabha 2009 elections, 138 were crorepatis. 88% of candidates of INC were crorepatis and more that 86% of NCP's candidates were crorepatis.

Figure: Crorepati candidates from major parties






Analysis based on assets- for MPs

Out of 48 MPs from Maharashtra in Lok Sabha 2009, 38 are crorepatis as compared to 20 crorepati MPs in Lok Sabha 2004. There has been an increase of 90% in number of crorepati MPs from Lok Sabha 2004. The average asset of a MP in Lok Sabha 2004 was Rs 212 lakhs which rose to Rs 807 lakhs in 2009. Between Lok Sabha 2004 & Lok Sabha 2009 there has been an average asset increase of 281% for MPs.






