

Analysis of MLAs and Chief Ministers of Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Goa and Manipur (2007-2012)

Highlights

- National Election Watch (NEW) have analyzed the affidavits submitted to the Election Commission of India of all the 5 Chief Ministers in the five states of Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Goa and Manipur.
- Ms. Mayawati, Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, has the highest assets 87.27 crores among the Chief Ministers of the 5 states
- Mr. Okram Ibobi Singh, Chief Minister of Manipur has the lowest assets worth 6.09 Lakhs
- Mr. Prakash Singh Badal, Chief Minister of Punjab, is the only one who has got a criminal case amongst the 5 Chief Ministers. He faces charges of cheating, forgery, criminal conspiracy etc.
- Ms. Mayawati, Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh is the only female Chief Minister amongst the 5 Chief Ministers.
- Except for Okram Ibobi Singh, Chief Minister of Manipur, everyone else has declared their PAN information.
- All the 5 Chief Ministers are graduates with Maj. Gen (Retd.) Bhuwan Chandra Khanduri, Chief Minister of Uttarakhand holding a Post Graduate Degree.
- National Election Watch (NEW) in the five states of Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Goa and Manipur have analyzed the affidavits of all 690 MLAs in the 5 states.
- 28% MLAs i.e. (190 out of 690 analyzed) have self declared pending criminal charges as per their affidavits in the previous Assembly Elections. 89 MLAs out of these 690 analyzed have declared serious IPC charges like murder and attempt to murder charges against them.
- Uttar Pradesh has the maximum percentage of MLAs (35%) with pending criminal cases, with 143 out of 403 MLAs charged with criminal cases. Out of the 143, 76(19%) MLAs have serious criminal cases pending against them.
- Dhirendra Pratap Singh of BSP in Uttar Pradesh has the highest number of criminal cases, (29) followed by Sushil Kumar also of the BSP in Uttar Pradesh with 14 cases pending against him. The charges are related to murder, attempt to murder etc.
- A total of 239 MLAs (i.e. 35% of the total analyzed) are crorepatis.
- Out of the 690 MLAs analyzed , 235 have not given their PAN details
- Out of 690 MLAs only 35(5%) are women

Background

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations, has been working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India. National Election Watch (NEW) groups in the five states of Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Goa and Manipur have analyzed the affidavits of 690 MLAs out of the total 690 MLAs in the 5 states.

This report is based on the analysis of these affidavits. The following pages give state- wise analysis of criminal, financial and other background information of the MLAs.

Analysis of MLAs of Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Manipur and Goa

Analysis Based on Pending Criminal Cases

Pending Criminal Cases against MLAs

- There are 190 MLAs out of the 690 analyzed, (i.e. about 28 %) who have criminal cases pending against them as per their self sworn affidavits given to the Election Commission.
- Out of the 190 MLAs analyzed with pending criminal cases, 89 have declared serious IPC charges like murder and attempt to murder charges against them.
- Uttar Pradesh has the maximum % of MLAs (35%) with pending criminal cases, with 143 out of 403 MLAs charged with criminal cases. Out of the 143, 76(19%) MLAs have serious criminal cases pending against them with charges relating to murder, attempt to murder etc.

Analysis Based on Assets

A total of 239 MLAs out of 690 analyzed i.e. 35% of the total number of MLAs (analyzed) contesting in the 5 states are crorepati. 67% of MLAs analyzed of Punjab are crorepati followed by 55% of MLAs of Goa and 32% of MLAs of Uttar Pradesh.
