

Summary and Highlights

Himachal Pradesh Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all **68** MLAs from the Himachal Pradesh 2017 Assembly Elections.

Criminal Background

- **MLAs with Criminal Cases:** Out of the **68** MLAs analysed, **22(32%)** MLAs have declared criminal cases against them. Out of 68 MLAs analysed during **Himachal Pradesh Assembly elections in 2012**, **14 (21%)** MLAs had **declared criminal cases** against themselves.
- **MLAs with Serious Criminal Cases:** **8 (12%)** MLAs have declared serious criminal cases against them. Out of **68** MLAs analysed during **Himachal Pradesh Assembly elections in 2012**, **5 (7%)** MLAs had **declared serious criminal cases** against themselves.
- **Party wise MLAs with Criminal Cases:** **2(10%)** out of 21 MLAs from **Indian National Congress (INC)**, **18(41%)** out of 44 MLAs from **Bhartiya Janta Party (BJP)**, **1(100%)** MLA from **CPI (M)** and **1(50%)** out of 2 **Independent** MLAs have declared criminal cases against them in their affidavits.
- **Party wise MLAs with Serious Criminal Cases:** **1(5%)** out of 21 MLAs from **Indian National Congress (INC)**, **6(14%)** out of 44 MLAs from **Bhartiya Janta Party (BJP)** and **1(100%)** MLA from **CPI (M)** have declared serious criminal cases against them in their affidavits.



Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.




Figure: Party Wise MLAs with Criminal Cases




Figure : Share of Wealth among MLAs

- **Crorepati MLAs:** Out of the 68 MLAs analysed, **52 (76%)** are crorepatis. Out of **68** MLAs analysed during **Himachal Pradesh 2012 assembly elections**, **44 (65%)** MLAs were crorepatis.
- **Party wise Crorepati MLAs:** **21 (100%)** out of 21 MLAs from **INC**, **28 (64%)** out of 44 MLAs from **BJP**, **1 (100%)** MLA from **CPI (M)**, and **2 (100%)** **Independent** MLAs have declared assets worth more than Rs. 1 crore.




Figure: Party Wise Crorepati MLAs

- **Average assets:** The average of assets per MLA contesting in the Himachal Pradesh Assembly Elections 2017 is **Rs 8.88 Crores**. In 2012, the average assets MLAs analyzed was **Rs 7.45 crores**.
- **Party wise average assets:** Among the major parties, the average assets per MLA for **21 INC** MLAs is **Rs 13.80 crores**, **44 BJP** MLAs have average assets of **Rs 6.14 crores**, and **2 Independent** MLAs have average assets of **Rs. 12.85 Crores**.

- **Number of re-elected MLAs:** Number of re-elected MLAs analysed in the assembly elections of 2017 is 30
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2012:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2012 was Rs 5.79 crores
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2017:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2017 is Rs 10.39 crores
- **Average growth in assets of re-elected MLAs from 2012 to 2017:** The growth in average assets of re-elected MLAs is Rs 4.60 crores i.e. by 79%.

- **Education details of MLAs:** 21 (31%) MLAs have declared their educational qualification to be between 8th pass and 12th pass, while 47(69%) MLAs have declared having an educational qualification of **graduate or above**.
- **Age details of MLAs:** 20(29%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 25 and 50 years while 46(68%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 51 and 80 years and 1 MLA has declared his age **above 80 years**.
- **Gender details of MLAs:** Out of 68 MLAs, 4 (6%) MLAs are women. In 2012, out of 68 MLAs, 3 (4%) MLAs were women.




Figure: MLAs who have/have not declared sources of self-income




Figure: Party wise MLAs who have not declared their source of self-income




Figure 9: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of gender




Figure: Party Wise: Percentage of Women MLAs
