Summary and Highlights

ADR and Odisha Election Watch (OEW) have analysed the vote share for the 146 out of 147 constituencies in the Odisha Assembly Elections, 2019, as elections for Patkura constituency got cancelled.

Vote Share of Winners

- The winners of the Odisha Assembly Elections, 2019 won by an average of **46%** of total votes polled.
- **45(30.82%)** winners won with 50% and above of the total votes polled in their constituency.
- **101(69.17%)** winners won with less than 50% of the total votes polled in their constituency.
- Out of 112 winners of BJD, 68(60.71%) won with less than 50% of total votes polled in their constituencies. 8(88.88%) out of 9 winners from INC and 100% winners each from BJP, CPI(M) and Independent have won with less than 50% of total votes polled in their constituency.15(22.38%) out of 67 winners analysed with declared criminal cases have won with a vote share of 50% and above.
- **33(34.73%)** out of 95 crorepati winners analysed have won with a vote share of **50% and above**.

Margin of Victory

- 4 winners have won with margin of victory of less than 1000 votes.
- 2 winners have won with more than 40% of margin of victory.

Winners with Declared Criminal Cases and their Margin of Victory:

- 1. **26** out of 67 winners with declared criminal cases have won against a runner up with a clean background.
- 2. Among these 26 winners, 2 winners have won with more than 20% margin of victory.
- 3. Among these, Soumya Ranjan Patnaik (BJD) from Khandapada constituency won with 60.5 % margin of victory.
- 4. There are 38 winners with a clean background who have won against a runner up with declared criminal cases. Out of these 38 winners, 6 have won with more than 25 % margin of victory.





Crorepati Winners and their Margin of Victory:

- 1. 37 out of 95 crorepati winners have won against a non-crorepati runners up.
- 2. Among these 37 winners, 3 winners have won with more than 20 % margin of victory.
- **3.** Among these, Latika Pradhan (BJD) from Kabisuryanagar constituency won with 33.38% margin of victory.
- 4. There are 22 non-crorepati winners who have won against crorepati runners up. 2 of them have won with more than 25% of vote share.

Performance of Women Winners

- Among the 146 winners,13 are women.
- Among the women winners, Latika Pradhan (BJD) from **Kabisuryanagar** Constituency has won with the highest vote share, i.e. 62.87 % in her constituency and 33.38% of margin of victory.

Performance of Re-elected Winners

- Out of total 60 re-elected winners **20(33.33%)** have won with more than 50% of vote share.
- **12** re-elected winners have won with less than 5% of margin of victory whereas only 8 have won with more than 20% of margin of victory.

<u>NOTA</u>

• The NOTA button instated by the ECI in 2013 gave the voters an options of rejecting all the candidates in their constituency. Out of 2,34,17,695 votes polled in Odisha Assembly Election, 2019, 2,44,974 (1.05%) were polled for NOTA.





Vote Share of Winner

The percentage of vote share was calculated by dividing the votes polled for the winner by the total number of valid votes polled. The value of vote share represents votes won by the winning candidates among the total number of valid votes polled.

> Votes Share = (Total Votes Polled for Winner) (Total No. of Valid Votes Polled)

The winners of the Odisha Assembly Elections, 2019 won by an average of 46 % of total votes polled.




Figure: No. of Winners- Vote Share




Figure: Vote Share Percentage of Winners- Odisha Assembly 2009, 2014 and 2019




Figure: Party Wise Vote Share Percentage




Figure: Vote Share of Winners with declared criminal cases and Crorepati Winners




Figure: Winners with Margin of Victory less than 1000 votes




Figure: Margin of Victory of Winners with declared criminal cases and Crorepati Winners








Figure: Performance of Women Winners




Figure: Performance of Re-Elected Winners
