Summary and Highlights

The Jharkhand Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of **14** newly elected MPs.

Criminal Background

- MPs with Criminal Cases: Out of 14 MPs analyzed, 4(29%) MPs have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- MPs with Serious Criminal Cases: 2(14%) MPs have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.

Analysis of Assets of Re-elected MPs

- Average Assets in 2014: The average assets of these 8 re-elected MPs in 2014 was Rs 12.10 Crores.
- Average Assets in 2019 Elections: The average asset of these 8 re-elected MPs in 2019 is Rs 19.66 Crores.
- <u>Average Asset growth in 5 years (2014-2019)</u>: The average asset growth for these 8 re-elected MPs, between the Lok Sabha Elections of 2014 and 2019 is **Rs 7.55 Crores**.
- Percentage growth in 5 years (2014-2019): Average percentage growth in assets for these 8 re-elected MPs is 62%.
