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Summary and Highlights

The Jharkhand Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of **14** newly elected MPs.

Criminal Background

- **MPs with Criminal Cases:** Out of 14 MPs analyzed, **4(29%)** MPs have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **MPs with Serious Criminal Cases:** **2(14%)** MPs have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

- **Average Asset growth in 5 years (2014-2019):** The average asset growth for these 8 re-elected MPs, between the Lok Sabha Elections of 2014 and 2019 is **Rs 7.55 Crores**.
- **Percentage growth in 5 years (2014-2019):** Average percentage growth in assets for these 8 re-elected MPs is **62%**.
