## Summary and Highlights

The National Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of **433** MPs and MLAs, who changed parties and recontested elections held during the last 5 years.

### Party-wise share of MPs and MLAs who changed Political Parties

- **170(42%)** MLAs left INC to join another party during the elections held between 2016-2020. While only **18 (4.4%)** MLAs left BJP to join a different party to contest elections during this period.
- Between 2016-2020, **182 (44.9%)** out of 405 recontesting MLAs who switched political parties joined the BJP followed by **38 (9.4%)** MLAs who joined INC and **25 (6.2%)** MLAs who joined TRS.
- **5(41.7%)** Lok Sabha MPs left BJP to join another party during the Lok Sabha elections 2019. While **7 (43.8%)** Rajya Sabha MPs left INC to join a different party to contest elections during the elections held between 2016-2020.
- Between 2016-2020, **10 (62.5%)** out of 16 recontesting Rajya Sabha MPs who switched political parties joined the BJP and **5 (41.7%)** out of 12 Lok Sabha MPs who changed parties joined INC in the Lok Sabha Election 2019.
- It is to be noted that the recent fall of governments in Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Goa, Arunachal Pradesh and Karnataka State Assemblies were due to defections of their MLAs.

## COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF ASSETS OF RE-CONTESTING AND RE-ELECTED MPs AND MLAs

- **Number of re-contesting MPs/ MLAs:** Number of re-contesting MPs and MLAs analysed PAN India since 2016 is **433**.
- **Average assets of re--contesting MPs/ MLAs in the last elections:** The average assets of re-contesting MPs and MLAs analysed PAN India since 2016 was **Rs 14.95 crores**.
- **Average assets of re-contesting MPs/ MLAs in the current elections:** The average assets of re-contesting MPs and MLAs analysed PAN India since 2016 is **Rs 20.80 crores**.
- **Average growth in assets of re-contesting MPs and MLAs since 2016:** The growth in average assets of re-contesting MPs and MLAs is **Rs 5.85 crore i.e. by 39%**.

### Observations of ADR

1. **The principles of democracy rely upon ‘government of the people, by the people and for the people’ where ‘interest of citizens’ is of paramount importance in comparison to ‘private interest of our politicians’.** This fundamental principal, however, has become skewed with the failing standards of ethical and moral propriety of India’s parliamentary democracy. The **‘Aaya Ram, Gaya Ram’** syndrome and the never ending **‘hunger for power and money’** has become a common practice amongst our Parliamentarians and Political parties. **The most plausible reasons behind such defections and switching of parties are;**
  - I. **absence of value-based politics**
  - II. **Lust for money and power**
  - III. **Strong nexus between money and muscle**
  - IV. **Reward for office**
  - V. **Dearth of efficient, honest and credible leaders**
  - VI. **Silent/absent laws on political parties functioning**
  - VII. **Misuse of power under Section 321 of the Cr.PC by withdrawal from prosecution against a particular politician(s) and unimpeded entry of criminals into politics.**

2. Until and unless these trends are not reined in, our current electoral and political situation is bound to deteriorate further. The ***‘Conduct of Politics’ necessitates fairness, freedom, reliability, equality, integrity, honesty, and credibility.*** It will be a mockery of democracy if we fail to plug these loop-holes because of which such defections, changing/switching of party by MPs and MLAs are happening. ***It is high time that our political parties and politicians put an end to the ‘politics of convenience and self-gain’ and start practicing ‘politics of conviction, courage and consensus’.***

### **Recommendations of ADR:**

- 1) **Amendment to the 10<sup>th</sup> Schedule of the Constitution:** As per the recommendations of various committees such as the Dinesh Goswami Committee (1990), the 170<sup>th</sup> Law Commission Report(1999), National Commission to Review the Working of Constitution (NCRWC) Report (2002),) in order to curb the frequent practice of defections by ministers, the 10<sup>th</sup> Schedule of the Constitution should be amended and ***instead of the Presiding Officer (i.e Chairman or the Speaker), the decision to disqualify a member should be made by the President (in case of MPs) or the Governor (in case of MLAs) on the advice of the Election Commission.*** In addition, ***a provision should be made for debarring the defector from holding public office or any remunerative post until the next fresh elections or the duration of the remaining term of the legislature. The vote cast by a defector to topple a government should be treated as invalid. The practice of having oversized Council of Ministers must also be prohibited by law.*** A ceiling on the number of Ministers in any State or the Union Government be fixed at the maximum of ten percent of the total strength of the popular House of the Legislature.
- 2) **Declare Political parties as Public Authorities:** It is the political parties that form the government, man the Parliament and run the governance of the country. Bringing political parties under the ambit of Right to Information Act,2005 will not only usher transparency and accountability in the functioning of political parties and party leaders but it will also give a chance to the citizens to play their part in a democracy by acting as a watchdog. The ***public character, nature of duties and criticality of the role being played by the political parties in our democratic set up mandates that the 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2013 CIC order that declared six national political parties namely; INC, BJP, CPI, CPI(M). NCP & BSP as public authorities is implemented in its letter and spirit.***

- 3) **A comprehensive law to regulate political parties' affairs:** Political parties are the ultimate repository and guardian of our whole constitutional, democratic, social-economic set up but we don't have a single law dealing with political parties. ***In absence of a comprehensive law, citizens cannot question, appraise and audit the functioning of political class and politicians.*** Therefore, there is a dire need for a comprehensive legislation ***regulating the functioning of political parties, recognition of their party constitution, election at various levels of party organs, conditions for registration and de-registration, compulsory maintenance of accounts, women representation at organisational positions,*** as recommended in the '170th Law Commission Report, Part III, Chapter I' and Chapter 8 of the NCRW report.
- 4) **Prior announcement of candidates contesting elections:** ***List of candidates*** contesting elections should be ***announced 6 months prior to elections*** and they should be required ***to submit affidavits stating specific reasons for changing/joining a particular party expected and approximate amount to be spent by them in the next elections and of the source thereof.*** All this information should be brought in the public domain.
- 5) **Introduce provisions for inner-party democracy within political parties:** In spite of being one of the largest democracies in the world, our political parties which run this democracy are painfully undemocratic in their functioning. Political parties have miserably failed in their 'Code of conduct' and self-initiated reforms for themselves. Therefore, mandatory provisions should be made to ***introduce inner-party democracy, transparent decision-making, ticket distribution, elections of office bearers, financial transparency and stronger organisational discipline*** within the political parties. This should include ***mandatory secret ballot voting for all elections for all inner party posts and selection of candidates, as suggested by the 170<sup>th</sup> Law Commission Report.***
- 6) **Criteria for selection of candidates:** There should be a strict criterion for selection of candidates by political parties. As per the ***Supreme Court judgment*** dated ***13<sup>th</sup> February, 2020,*** political parties are already required to give ***reasons for selection*** of candidates and ***why other individuals without criminal antecedents could not be selected as candidates.*** As per the judgment the reasons as to selection shall be with reference to the ***qualifications, achievements and merit of the candidate concerned,*** and not mere "winnability" at the polls.

- 7) **Cross- verification of assets of re-contesting MPS and MLAs:** There should be a strict mechanism for *cross- verification of assets of MPS and MLAs including their immediate family members; spouse/children/other dependents* who have defected, changed/joined a particular political party and where it is seen that *there is a dubious multiplication of assets of an MP/MLA after changing/switching a particular political party.*
- 8) **Fast tracking of cases for MLAs/MPs-** All pending cases against MPs and MLAs should be fast tracked and brought to conclusion *within a period of one year as mandated by the Supreme Court orders dated 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2014 and 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2017* so that *politicians do not defect/change/join a particular political party with the mere intention of 'withdrawal from prosecution' by 'party in power' under Section 321 of the Cr.P.C.* This will also help in ensuring that such unbridled and arbitrary power given under Section 321 is not misused by the governments of the day by ordering withdrawal of cases pending against powerful politicians, ministers and other rich and powerful people.
- 9) **Annual Report by MPs and MLAs -** Elected MPs and MLAs should be required to submit an '*Annual Report' to their constituency giving details of their accomplishments for previous year and the plan for the next year.* This report can be made available either at the Lok Sabha/Rajya Sabha website or at Election Commission's website.
- 10) **First -past -the -post, "50% + 1 of the registered votes cast":** As per the recommendations given by various committees like Law Commission, NCRW, '*no candidate should be declared elected unless he or she secures more than 50% of the votes cast*'. In the case when no candidate gets required number of voters, *there should be a runoff between the top two candidates getting maximum votes.* It is worth noting that 50%+1 of the votes cast is an easier requirement for being declared elected, a more stringent requirement, and the ideal to ensure appropriate and proper representation, would be 50%+1 of the registered votes.
- 11) **Disallowance of contesting by candidates from more than two constituencies:** As per the recommendation given by NCRW (2001) in its report titled "*Review of Working of Political Parties Specially in Relation to Election and Reforms*", Para No. 8.7(e), *candidates should not be allowed to contest election simultaneously for the same office from more than one constituency.*

- 12) Practice of creating number of offices at ministerial level should be completely banned:** As per the recommendation given by NCRW (2001) in its report titled “*Review of Working of Political Parties Specially in Relation to Election and Reforms*”, Para 8.16, point no. 4, ***the practice of creating a number of political offices equivalent to the position or privileges of a minister should also be stopped.*** Any new administrative organization should only be created through regular administrative procedures and only if the provisions have been made in the regular budget estimates of the government concerned.
- 13) Affidavit information of candidates to be certified by Political Parties:** Since the candidates are given tickets largely by political parties without any public debate or involvement of their primary members, ***the information submitted in their affidavits should be certified by political parties.*** It is after all these parties only that know these candidates to be worthy enough to get their tickets. In case ***the information furnished by the candidates is found incorrect, the political party and its officer bearers should be held accountable.***
- 14) Remove the nexus between muscle and money from elections** –The nexus between politicians, bureaucrats and criminal elements in our society has been on the rise, the adverse effects of which are increasingly being felt on various aspects of social life in India. Therefore, ***it is high time that such a strong criminal-political-bureaucratic nexus in our electoral and political process is strongly confronted by choosing honest, credible, clean and deserving candidates.***
- 15) Cancellation of tax exemptions given under Section 13A of the Income Tax Act:** As a step towards free and fair elections, there should ***be cancellation of tax exemption*** given to the political parties who deliberately give tickets ***to undeserving, dishonest, corrupt, moneyed and tainted candidates.*** In addition, the Election Commission of India (ECI) should exercise powers under Article 324 of the Constitution to ***de-register and de-recognise*** any political party if ***it knowingly puts up such candidates.***
