




Summary and Highlights

The National Election Watch and Association of Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of **6318 out of 6792** candidates who contested in the Union territory of Puducherry and 4 states of Assam, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal till Phase III. **474 candidates were not analysed due to unclear affidavit available on the ECI website at the time of making this report.**

Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- 6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.





Criminal Background

Candidates with Criminal cases: Out of 6318 candidates analysed, 1157 (18%) have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

Candidates with serious criminal cases: 632 (10 %) candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.




Figure: State wise candidates with criminal cases




Figure: Party wise Percentage of candidates with criminal cases




Figure: State Wise Percentage of Crorepati Candidates




Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Crorepati Candidates




Figure: State Wise Average Assets of Candidates




Figure: Analysis of Candidates on the basis of eduational qualification




Figure: Analysis of Candidates on the basis of age groups


