Puducherry Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 30 winning candidates in the Puducherry 2021 Assembly Elections.




Figure: Final Party Position

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND

- Winning candidates with criminal cases: Out of the 30 winning candidates analysed in 2021, 13(43%) winning candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of 30 MLAs analysed during Puducherry Assembly elections in 2016, 11(37%) MLAs had declared criminal cases against themselves.
- <u>Winning candidates with serious criminal cases:</u> 6 (20%) winning candidates have declared serious criminal cases including cases related to attempt to murder, Electoral Violations etc.





Figure: Comparison of declared criminal cases of MLAs of 2016 vs Winning candidate 2021



Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- 6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.

- Winning candidates with cases related to Attempt to Murder: 1 winner candidate has declared cases related to attempt to murder (IPC Section-307) against himself.
- Winning candidates with cases related to Electoral Violations: 1 winner candidate has declared cases of Punishment for bribery (IPC Section-171E).
- Party wise Winning candidates with Criminal Cases: 4 (67%) out of 6 winning candidates from BJP, 3(50%) out of 6 winning candidates from DMK, 3(30%) out of 10 winning candidates from All India N.R. Congress and 3(50%) out of 6 Independent winning candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- Party wise Winning candidates with Serious Criminal Cases: 3 (50%) out of 6 winning candidates from DMK and 1 candidate each from BJP, All India N.R. Congress and Independent winner candidate have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.




Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Winning Candidates with Criminal Cases





FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

• <u>Crorepati Winning candidates</u>: Out of the 30 winning candidates analysed, **25 (83%)** are crorepatis. Out of **30** MLAs analysed during **Puducherry assembly elections 2016**, **25 (83%)** MLAs were crorepatis.




Figure: Comparison of crorepati MLAs 2016 and Winning candidates 2021

• Party-wise crorepati winning candidates:6 (100%) out of 6 from BJP, 2 (100%) out of 2 from INC, 9 (90%) out of 10 from All India N.R. Congress, 3 (50%) out of 6 from DMK and 5 (83%) out of 6 Independent winning candidates have declared assets worth more than Rs. 1 crore.




Figure: Party wise Percentage of Crorepati Winning Candidates








Figure: Share of Wealth Among Winning Candidates




Figure: Comparison of Average Assets (Rs. in Crores): 2016 vs 2021

Congress winning candidates is Rs 11.21 Crores, 6 BJP winning candidates is Rs 11.26 crores, 2 INC winning candidates is Rs 7.74 crores and 6 DMK winning candidates have average assets worth Rs 7.15 Crores.

OTHER BACKGROUND DETAILS

- <u>Education Details of winning candidates:</u> 11 (37%) winning candidates have declared their educational qualification to be between 5th pass and 12th pass while 17 (57%) winning candidates have declared having an educational qualification of graduate and above. There is 1 winner candidate who is a Diploma Holder and 1 winner candidate is Illiterate.
- Age details of winning candidates: 13 (43%) winning candidates have declared their age to be between 25 and 50 years while 17 (57%) winning candidates have declared their age to be between 51 and 70 years.
- Gender details of winning candidates: Out of 30 winning candidates analysed, Only one winning candidates is a woman. In 2016, out of 30 MLAs, 4 (13%) MLAs were women.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF ASSETS OF RE-ELECTED MLAS

- Number of re-elected MLAs: Number of re-elected MLAs analysed in the Puducherry assembly elections of 2021 is 7.
- Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2016: The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2016 was Rs 17.34 crores.
- Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2021: The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2021 is Rs 20.57 crores.
- Average growth in assets of re-elected MLAs from 2016 to 2021: The growth in average assets of re-elected MLAs is Rs 3.22 crore i.e. by 19%.


