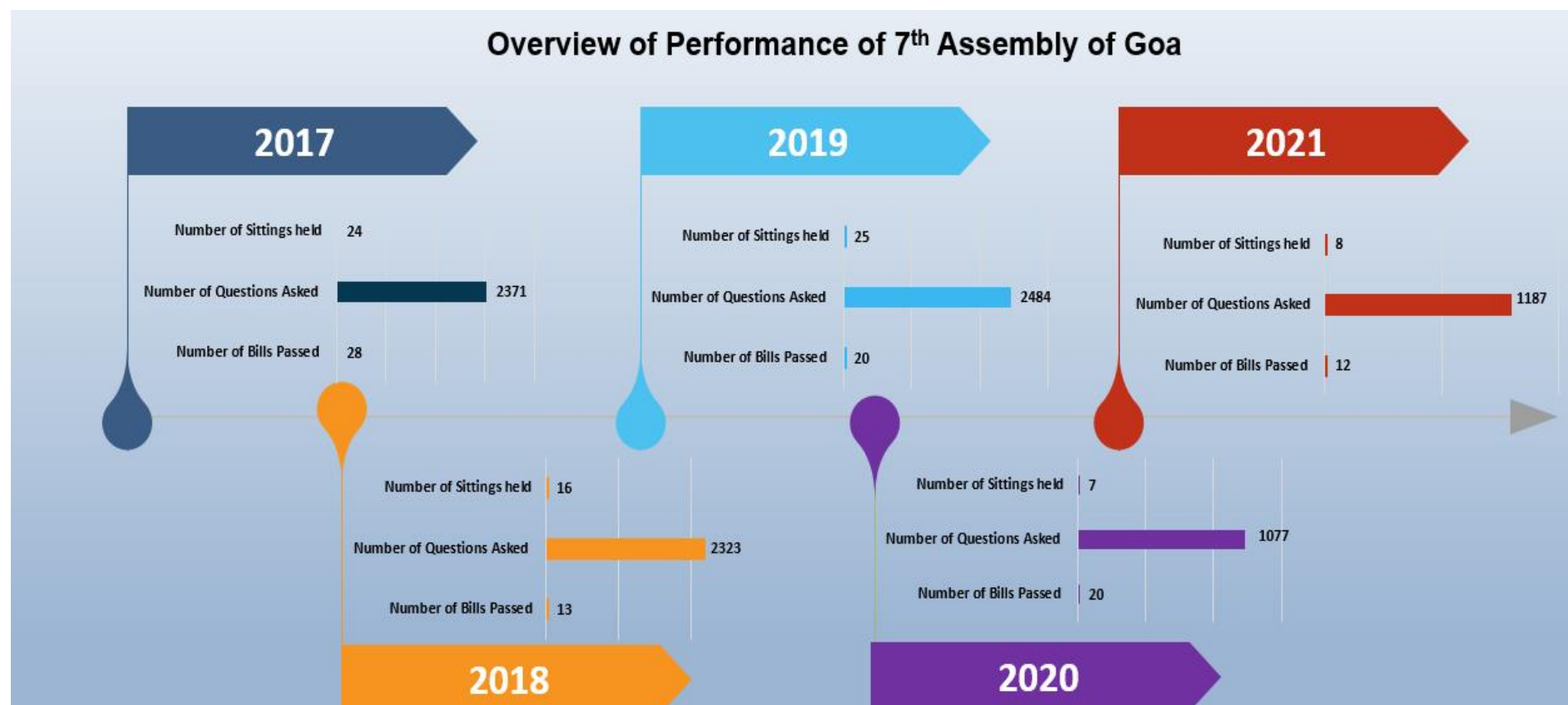

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Goa Election Watch (GEW) had filed RTIs to the Goa Assembly Secretariat asking for the information pertaining to the performance of the MLAs and the Legislative Assembly. This report has been generated from the information received **up to March 2021**. Whereas from 2017 to 2020 the report covers the complete calendar years, for the year 2021 the report covers data available from January to March 2021.

There are 40 seats in Goa Assembly, however this report also includes the analysis for the MLAs who have resigned or got elected through bye-elections.



Analysis of Number of Sitzings in Each Session of Goa Legislative Assembly

- On an average, Goa State Assembly sat for 16 days per year.
- The longest sessions was the 10th session, from 15th July, 2019 to 9 August, 2019. It had 20 sittings.

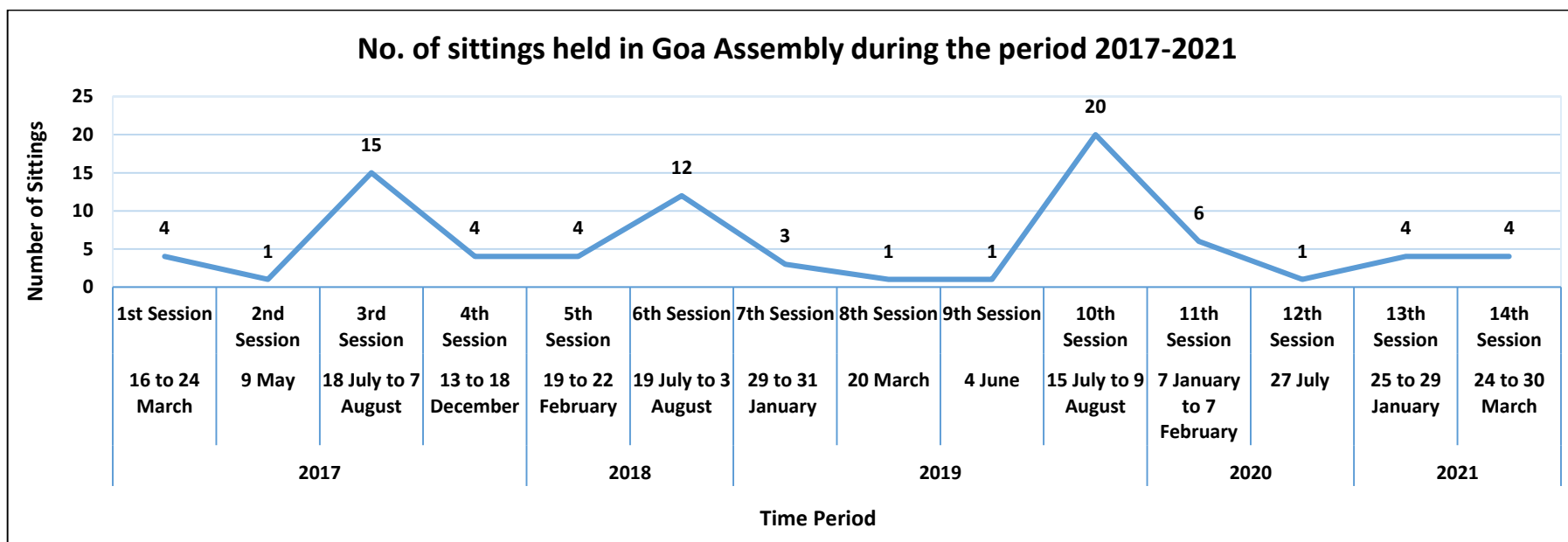


Figure: No. of sittings held in Goa Assembly during the period 2017-2021

- The highest number of hours contributed for assembly sittings were **154.01** hours in **2017** where assembly had **24** sittings.
- The lowest number of hours contributed for assembly sittings were **35.54** hours in **2020** where assembly had **7** sittings.

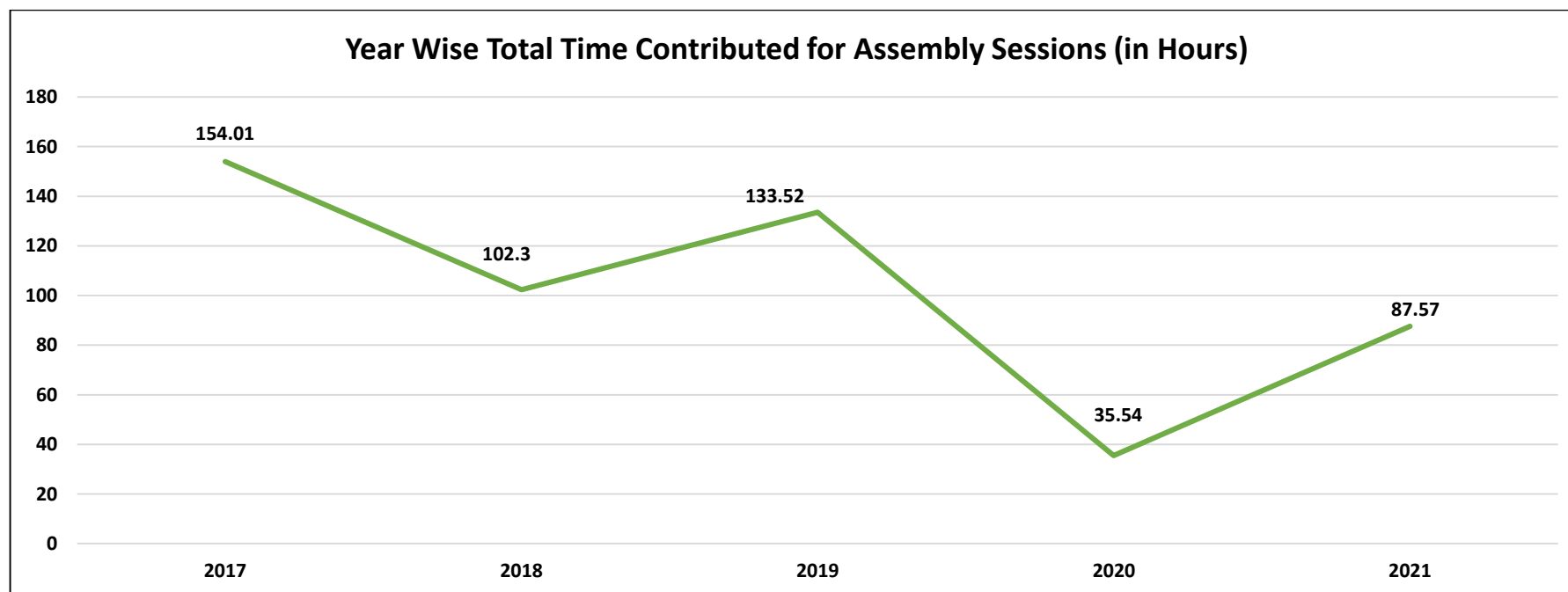


Figure: Year Wise Total Time Contributed for Assembly Sessions (in Hours)

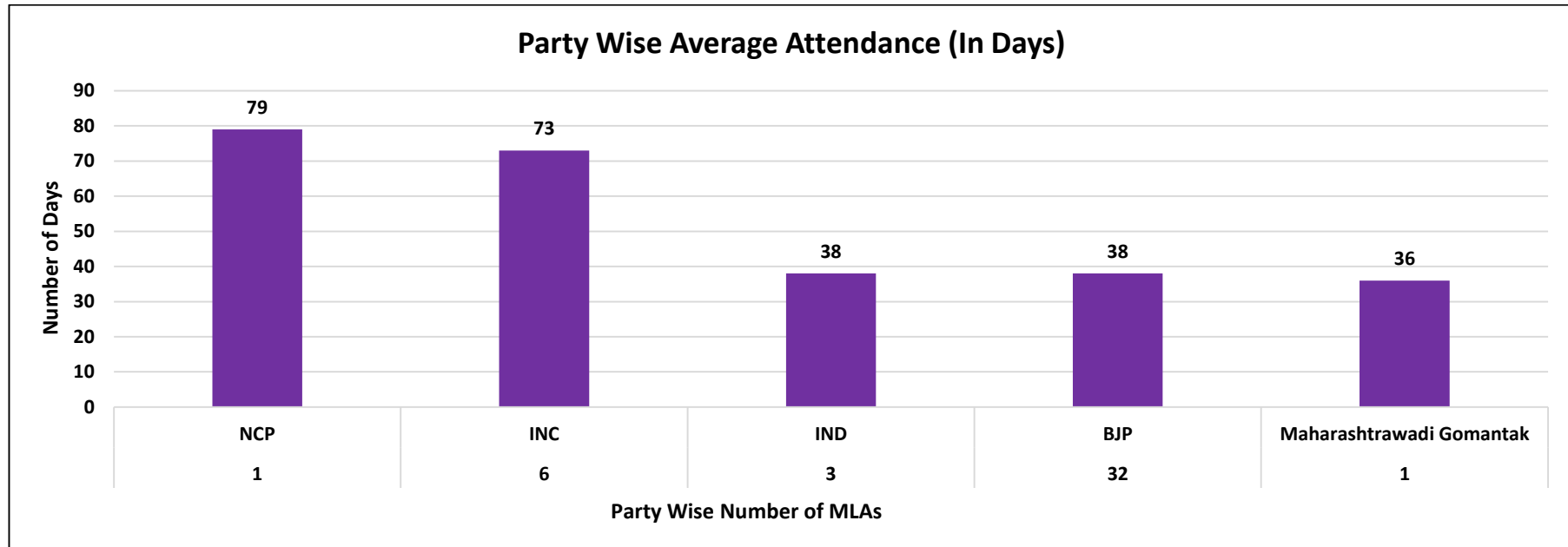


Figure: Party Wise Average Attendance

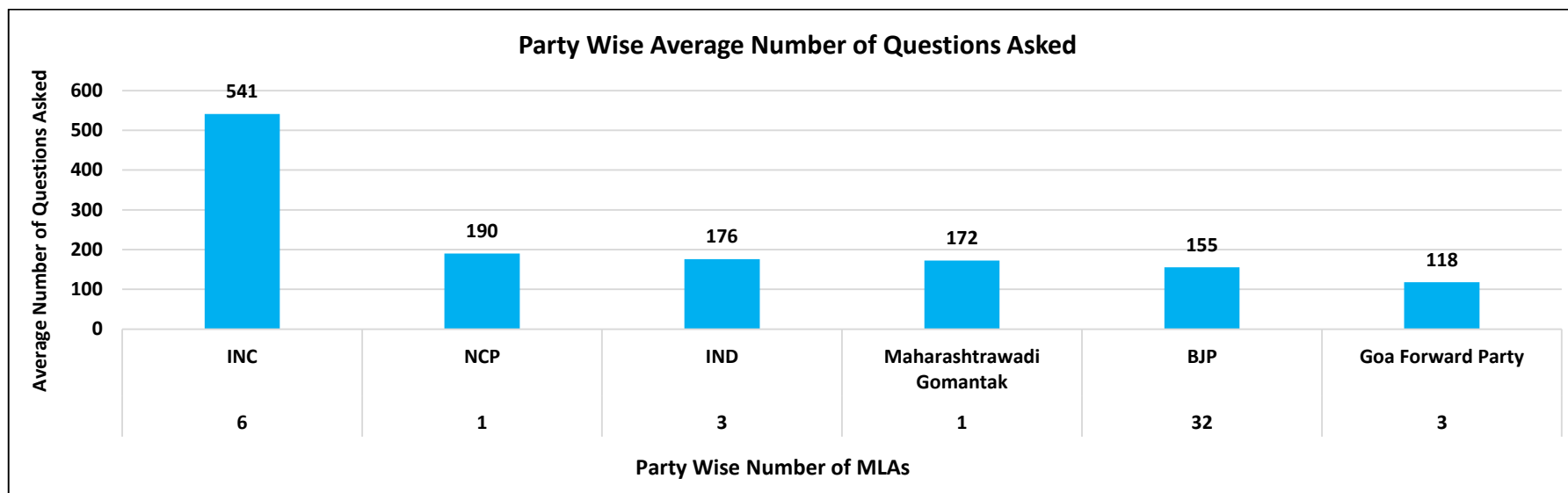


Figure: Party Wise Average Number of Questions Asked

- Highest number of Questions were related to Water, Panchayat and Rural Development and School and Education.

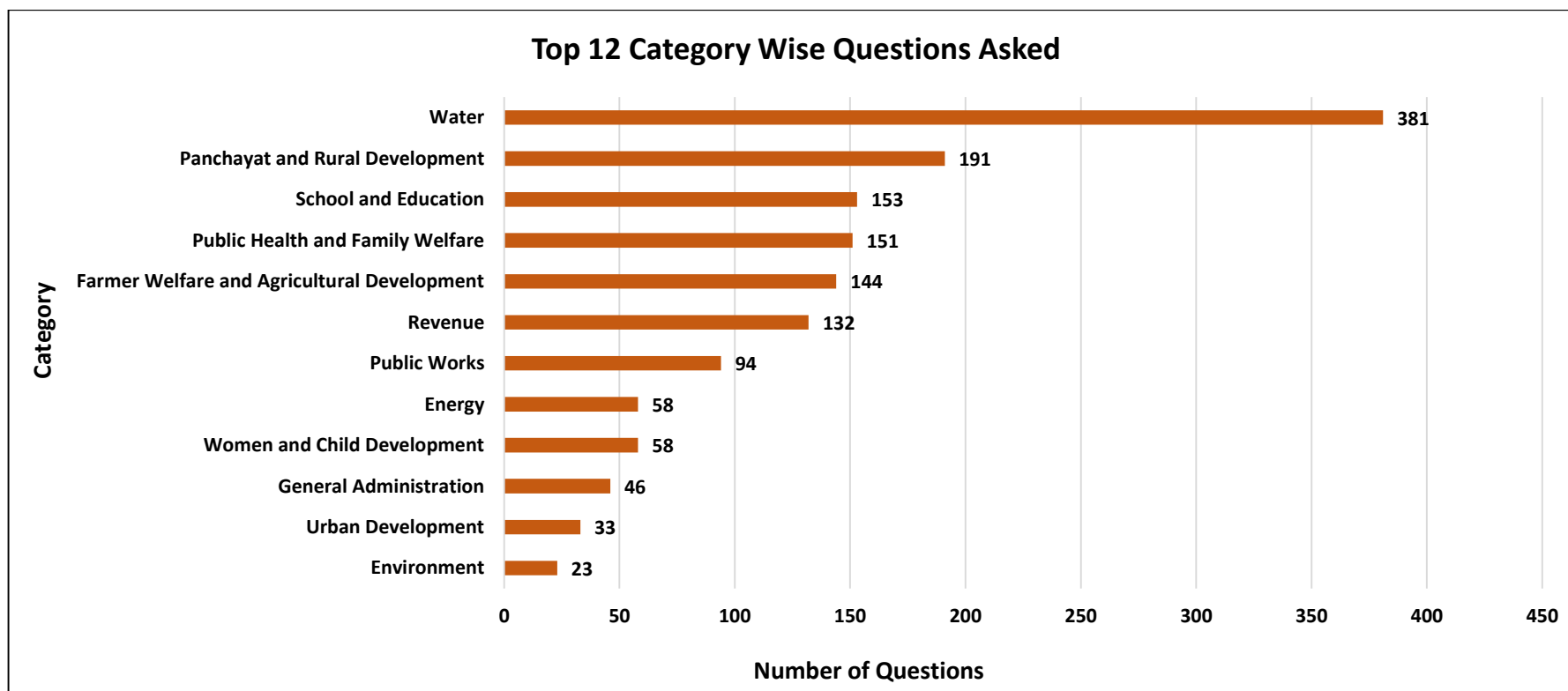


Figure: Top 12 - Category Wise Questions Asked

- There were a total of 93 Bills tabled in the 7th Goa Assembly and all of them were passed.

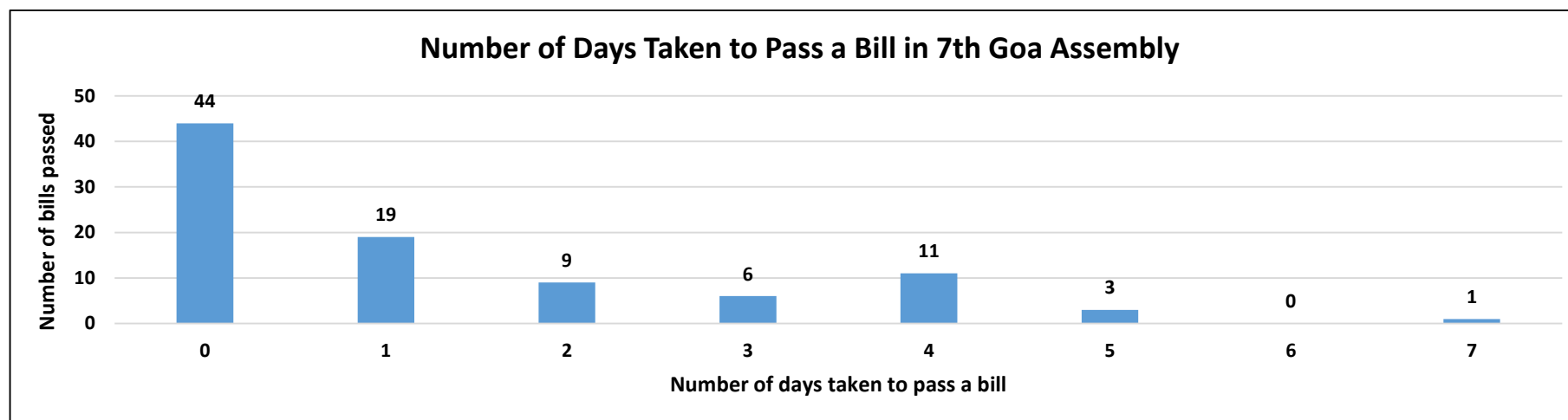


Figure: Time taken to Pass a Bill in 7th Goa Assembly

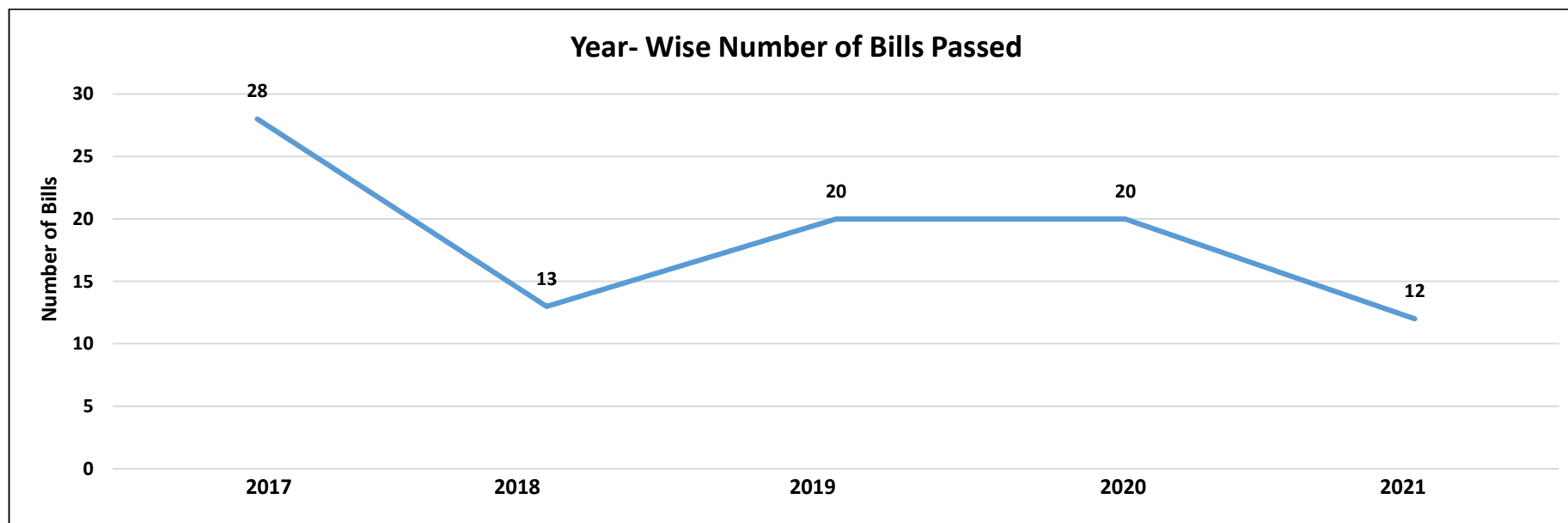


Figure: Number of Bills Passed in 7th Goa Assembly

Analysis of Number of Questions asked and Sittings Attended by MLAs in Goa Legislative Assembly

- On an average a MLA (including MLAs elected through bye-elections) from Goa Assembly has asked **205** questions, including starred questions and unstarred questions.
- On an average a MLA (including MLAs elected through bye-elections) from Goa Assembly has attended **43** out of **80** sittings held in the assembly.
- The details of these MLAs are given below:
