




Summary and Highlights

Tripura Election Watch and **Association for Democratic Reforms** have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all **9 Ministers** including Chief Minister from Tripura State Assembly 2023.

The information is based on the affidavits submitted by the candidates prior to 2023 Tripura Assembly Elections.

Criminal Background

- Ministers with Criminal Cases: 2(22%) ministers have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- Ministers with Serious Criminal Cases: 1(11%) minister has declared serious criminal case against himself.

Financial Background

- Crorepati Ministers: Out of the 9 ministers analysed, 4 (44%) are crorepatis.
- Average Assets: The average assets of 9 ministers analysed is Rs 3.37 crores.
- Minister with Highest Assets: The minister with the highest declared total assets is Manik Saha from Town Bardowali constituency with assets worth Rs. 13.90 crores.
- Minister with Lowest Assets: The minister with the lowest declared total assets is Sukla Charan Noatia from Jolaibari (ST) constituency with assets worth Rs. 2.06 lakhs.
- <u>Liabilities:</u> 8 ministers have declared liabilities out of which the minister with the highest liabilities is **Tinku Roy** of **Chandipur** constituency with **Rs. 50.67 lakhs** of liabilities.

Other Background details (Education, Gender, Age)

- Ministers' Education: 3 (33%) ministers have declared their educational qualification to be between 10th pass and 12th pass, while 6 (67%) ministers have declared having an educational qualification of graduate and above.
- Ministers' Age: 5 (56%) ministers have declared their age to be between 25 and 50 years while 4 (44%) ministers have declared their age to be between 51 and 80 years.
- Women Ministers: Out of 9 ministers, 1 is a woman.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.
