## Summary and Highlights

**Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Punjab Election Watch** have analyzed the criminal, financial and other background details of **113** out of **117** sitting MLAs. In current assembly 4 seats are vacant.

This analysis is based on the affidavits submitted by the candidates prior to the 2017 Assembly elections and bye elections conducted thereafter.

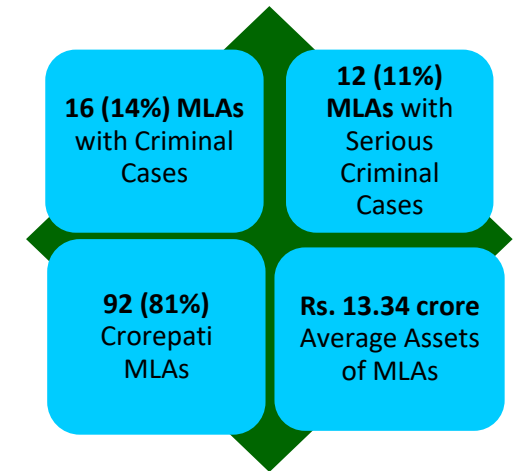

## CRIMINAL BACKGROUND

- **MLAs with criminal cases:** Out of **113** sitting MLAs analysed, **16 (14%) MLAs** have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **MLAs with serious criminal cases:** **12 (11%)** MLAs have declared serious criminal cases.
- **MLAs with declared cases related to murder:** **1** MLA has declared case related to murder (**IPC section 302**).
- **MLAs with declared cases related to attempt to murder:** **2** MLAs have declared cases related to attempt to murder (**IPC section 307**).
- **MLAs with cases related to Crimes against Women:** **1** MLA has declared cases related to crimes against women.
- **Party wise sitting MLAs with criminal cases:** **8 (10%)** out of 81 MLAs from **INC**, **3 (25%)** out of 12 MLAs from **AAP**, **2 (15%)** out of 13 MLAs from **SAD**, **1(100%)** out of 1 MLA from **Punjab Lok Congress** and **2 (100%)** out of 2 MLAs from **Lok Insaaf Party** have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- **Party wise sitting MLAs with serious criminal cases:** **6 (7%)** out of 81 MLAs from **INC**, **1 (8%)** out of 12 MLAs from **AAP**, **2 (15%)** out of 13 MLAs from **SAD**, **1(100%)** out of 1 MLA from **Punjab Lok Congress** and **2 (100%)** out of 2 MLAs from **Lok Insaaf Party** have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.



### Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

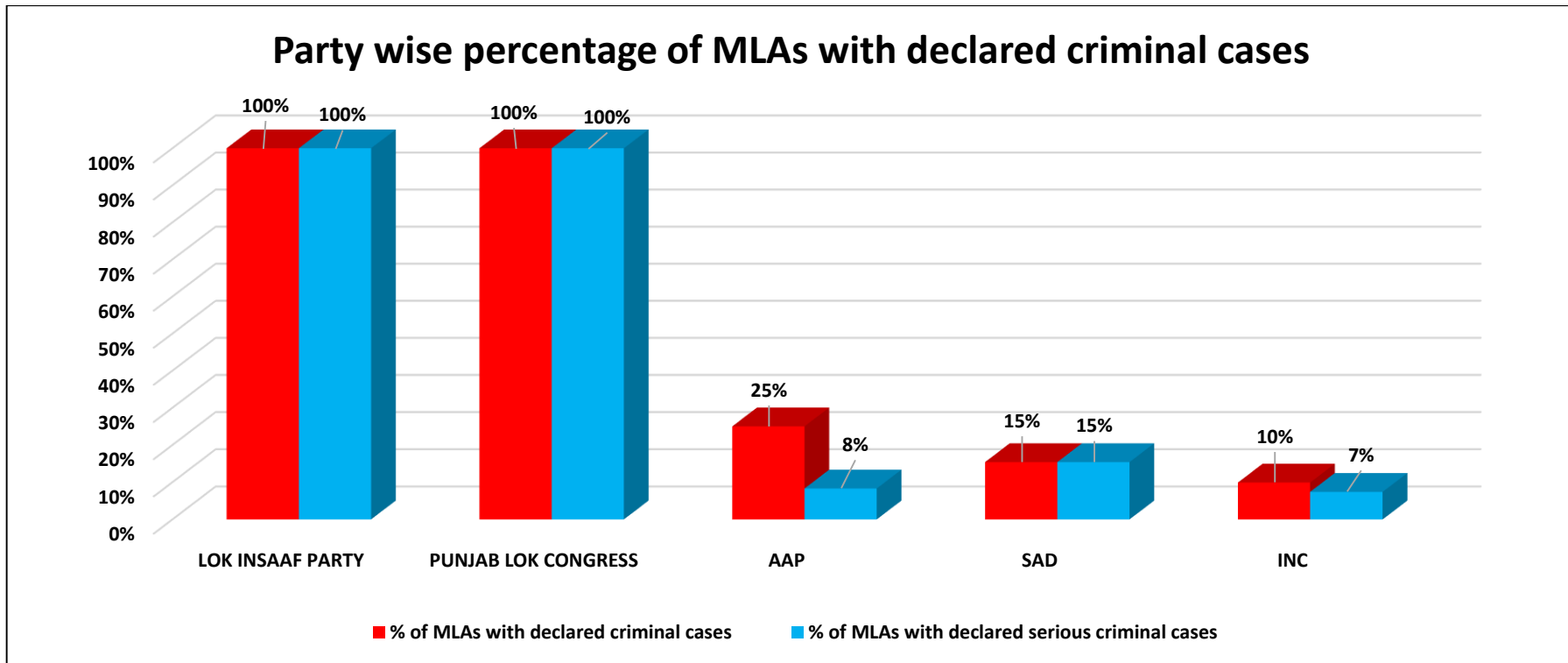


Figure: Party wise percentage of MLAs with declared criminal cases

## FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

- **Crorepati MLAs:** Out of 113 sitting MLAs analysed , 92 (81%) are crorepatis.
- **Party wise crorepati MLAs:** 69 (85%) out of 81 MLAs from INC, 13 (100%) out of 13 MLAs from SAD, 3 (25%) out of 12 MLAs from AAP, 3 (100%) out of 3 MLAs from BJP and 2 (100%) out of 2 MLAs from Lok Insaaf Party have declared assets valued more than Rs 1 crore.

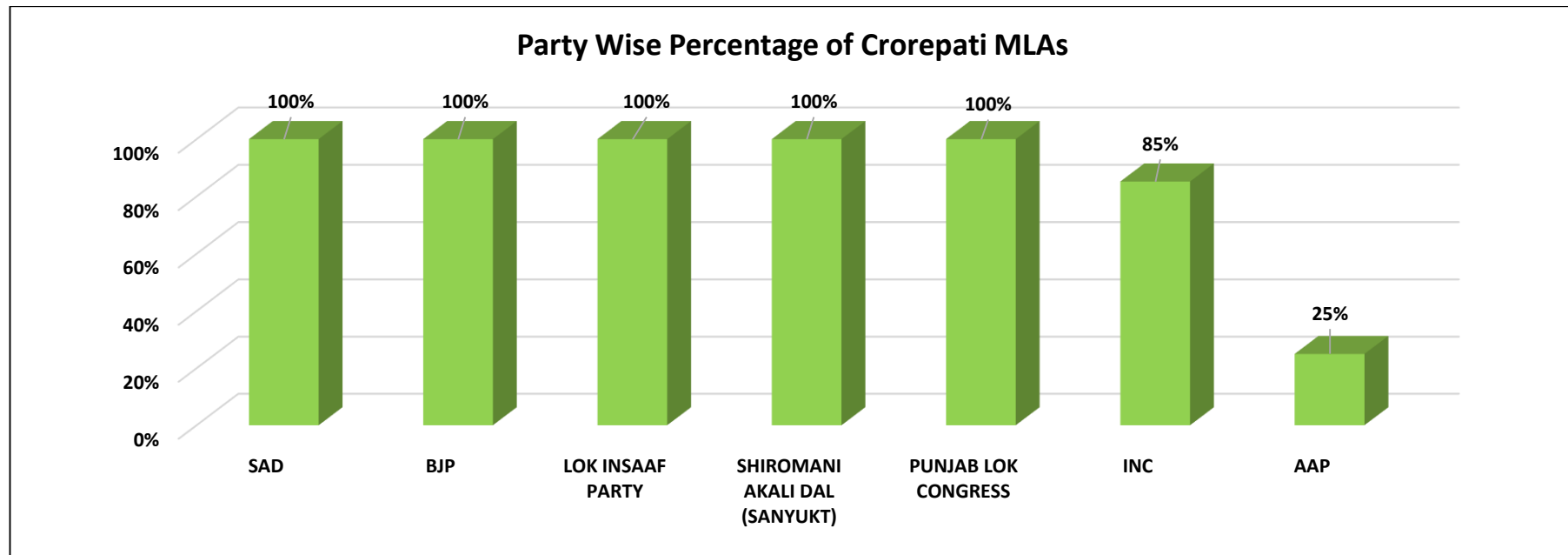


Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Crorepati MLAs

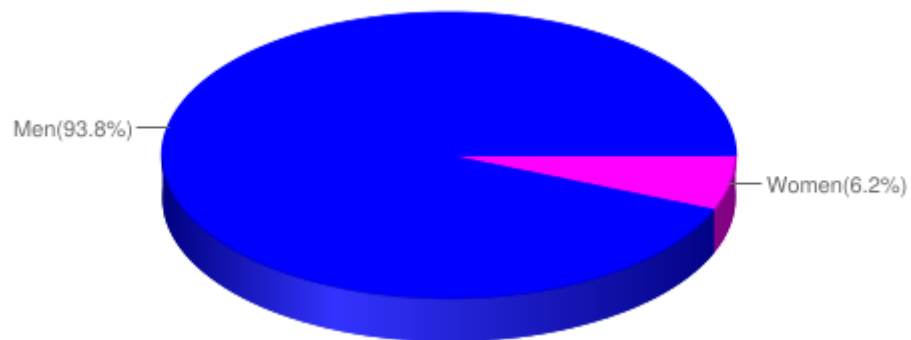
