

**Analysis of criminal and financial details
of candidates and MLAs
from Andhra Pradesh**

Andhra Pradesh Assembly 2009 elections were held along with Lok Sabha 2009 elections in two phases on April 16, 2009 & April 23, 2009. This report includes the analysis of voting trends, criminalization of politics, money power, gender etc in these elections. Information provided by ECI and details from the affidavits filed by contested candidates have been used for above analysis.

Executive summary for candidates and MLAs

Summary for candidates

- Affidavits of 2466 candidates out of total of 3655 candidates who contested Andhra Pradesh Assembly 2009 elections were analyzed by Andhra Pradesh Election Watch (APEW).
- Out of these 2466 candidates, 303 candidates or 12% declared pending criminal cases against them. INC had 36 out of 280 (13%) candidates with pending criminal cases, PRAP had 47 out of 254 (19%) candidates, BJP had 20 out of 168 (20%) candidates, TDP had 67 out of 211 (32%) candidates & TRS had 12 out of 39 (31%) candidates with pending criminal cases.
- Out of these 303 candidates with pending criminal cases, 116 had pending serious criminal cases like murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, robbery, extortion etc. INC had 11, PRAP had 17, BJP had 4, TDP had 22 & TRS had 4 candidates with pending serious criminal cases.
- There were 202 IPC charges of heinous nature on the candidates which included murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, extortion etc.
- There were total 34 red alert constituencies where 3 or more contesting candidates had pending criminal cases. Each Mydukur, Kamalapuram & Narasaraopet constituency had 5 contesting candidates with pending criminal cases.
- A total of 463 candidates out of 2466 i.e. 19% candidates were crorepatis.
- A total of 205 candidates declared zero assets.
- A total of 519 candidates declared liabilities of Rs.5 lakhs and above.
- Among major parties, the average asset per candidate for INC was Rs.2.89 crores, for PRAP Rs.3.21 crores, for BJP it was Rs.53.42 lakhs, for TDP it was Rs.3.42 crores & for TRS it was Rs.2.94 crores.
- A total of 62% of candidates (1537 of 2466) had not furnished PAN card details.
- Number of women candidates was just 215 (9%) as compared to 2251 of men (91%).
- More than 43% candidates (1053 of 2466) were graduates & above.

Summary for MLAs

- Out of 294 MLAs, analysis was done for 275 MLAs.
- Out of these 275 MLAs, 71 (26%) have pending criminal cases against them.
- Of the 116 candidates with the most serious criminal cases against them, only 26 won and the remaining 90 were rejected by the voters.
- Out of these 71 MLAs with pending criminal cases, 26 have pending serious criminal cases against them.
- Out of 275 MLAs analyzed, 147 MLAs (53%) are Crorepati.
- Among major parties, the average asset per winner for INC is Rs.3.25 crores, PRAP Rs. 10.37 crores, BJP Rs.4.35 crores, TDP Rs.4.23 crores & TRS Rs.1.35 crores.
- Average asset for a MLA in Andhra Pradesh is Rs 3.86 crores.
- Out of 275 MLAs, 78 have not declared their PAN details.
- Out of 215 women contestants, only 28 managed to win. Hence only 13% of MLAs in Andhra Pradesh are women.

Candidates vs MLAs

There are 294 constituencies in Andhra Pradesh for which elections were held. Maximum numbers of MLAs, 148 are from INC followed by 83 of TDP. The breakup of MLAs as compared to total candidates from the party are-

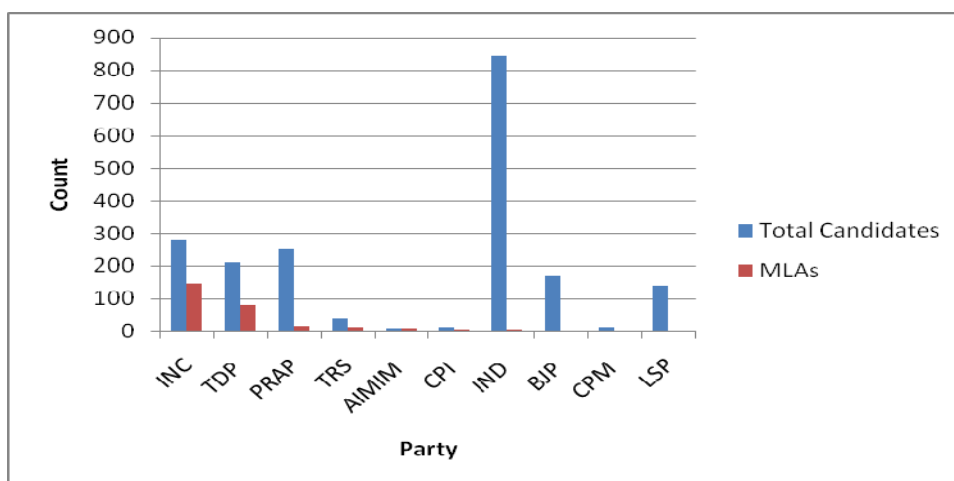


Figure: Candidates' vs MLAs- party wise

Analysis based on pending criminal cases

Analysis based on pending criminal cases- for candidates

A total of 2466 affidavits were analyzed by Andhra Pradesh Election Watch (APEW) for Assembly 2009 elections. Out of these 2466 candidates, 303 candidates or 12% declared pending criminal cases against them. Out of these 303 candidates with pending criminal cases, 116 candidates had pending serious criminal cases like murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, robbery, extortion etc.

Party wise break up for candidates with pending criminal cases

Total 303 candidates who contested in Andhra Pradesh Assembly 2009 had pending criminal cases against them. Out of 280 candidates of INC, 36 (13%) had pending criminal cases. A total of 47 out of 254 (19%) candidates of PRAP had pending criminal cases & 67 of 211 (32%) candidates of TDP had pending criminal cases. The break up is given in the table below.

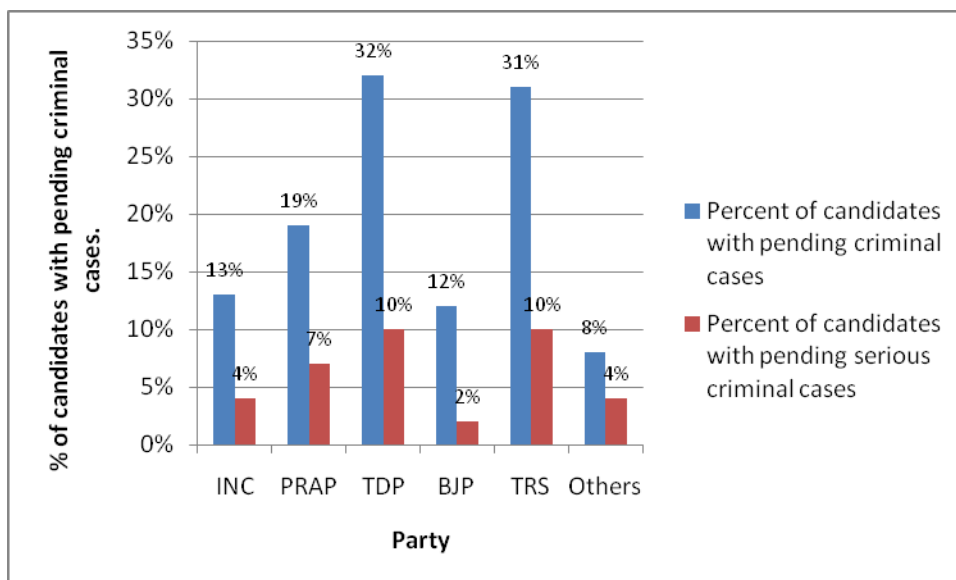


Figure: Comparison of pending criminal cases and serious pending criminal cases for candidates of main parties

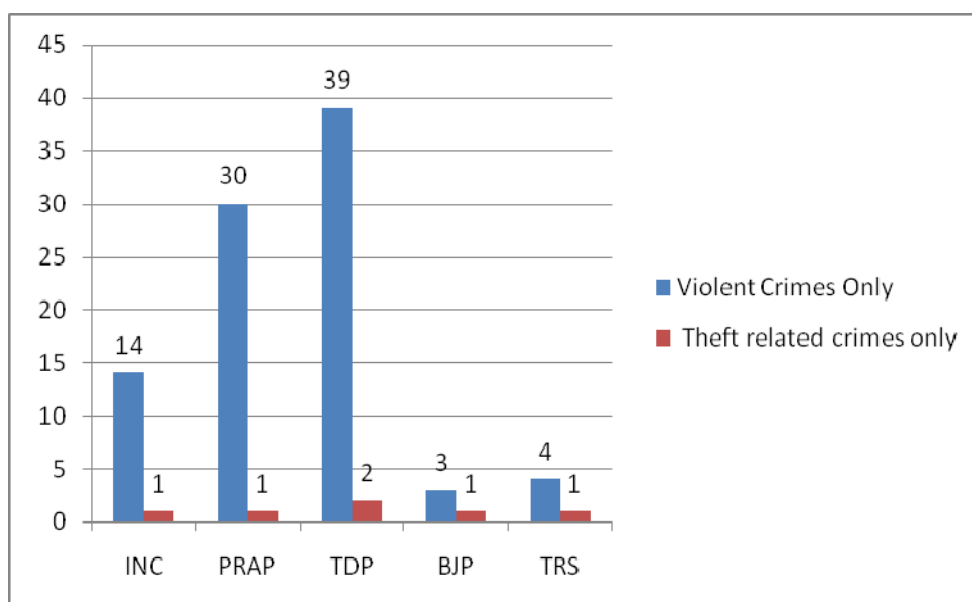


Figure: Serious IPC section break up for candidates of major parties

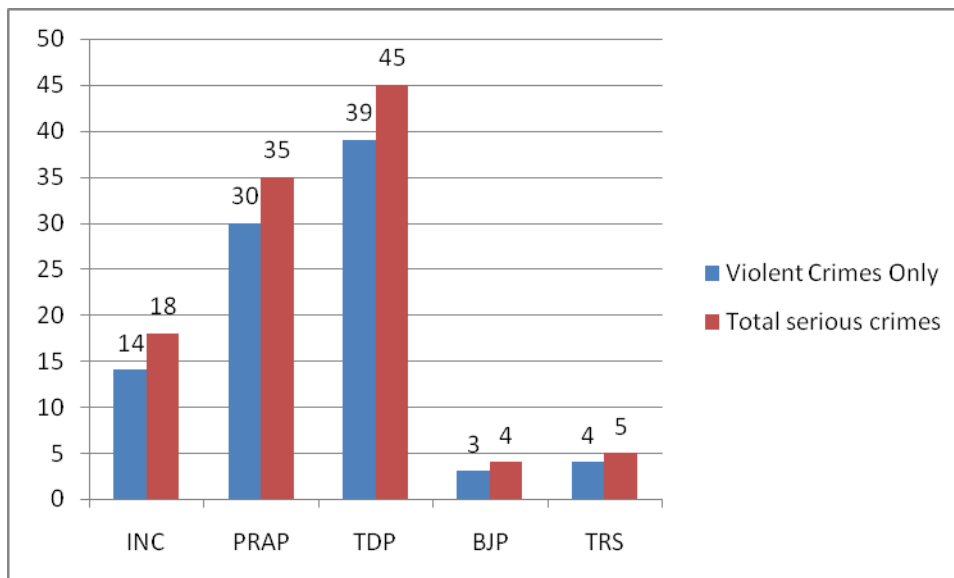


Figure: Comparison total serious crimes vs total violent crimes (murder, kidnapping etc) - party wise

Almost all of them had pending criminal cases of murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, dacoity etc. Out of these 20 candidates with most serious pending criminal cases, only 5 won and rest 15 were rejected by the voters. Analysis based on pending criminal cases – for MLAs

Out of 275 MLAs analysed for Andhra Pradesh Assembly 2009 Election, 71 MLAs have pending criminal cases against them. Out of these 71 MLAs, 26 have pending serious criminal cases against them.

Party wise break up for MLAs with pending criminal cases

Out of total 71 MLAs with pending criminal cases 35 are from TDP, 18 from INC & 7 are from PRAP.

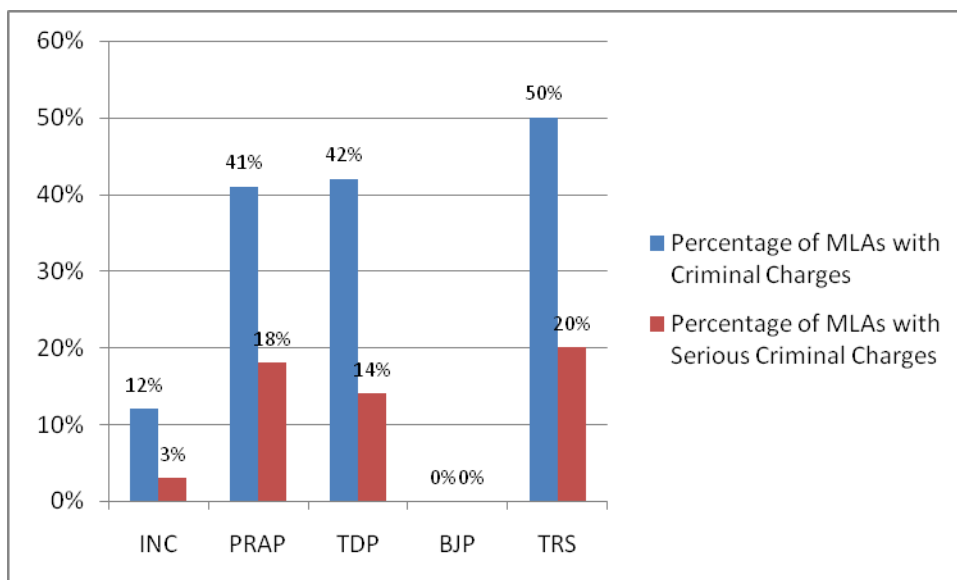


Figure: % winners with pending criminal cases

Analysis based on assets – for candidates

Out of 2466 candidates which were analysed for Andhra Pradesh 2009 Assembly, 463 (19%) were crorepatis. INC had 45% of its contesting candidates as crorepatis, whereas TDP had 50% crorepati candidates.

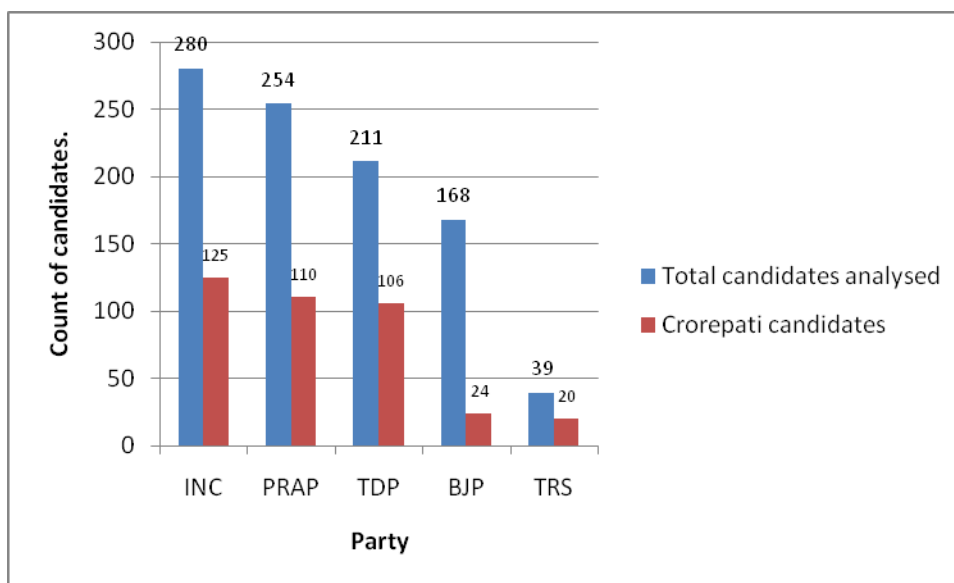


Figure: Crorepati candidates from major parties

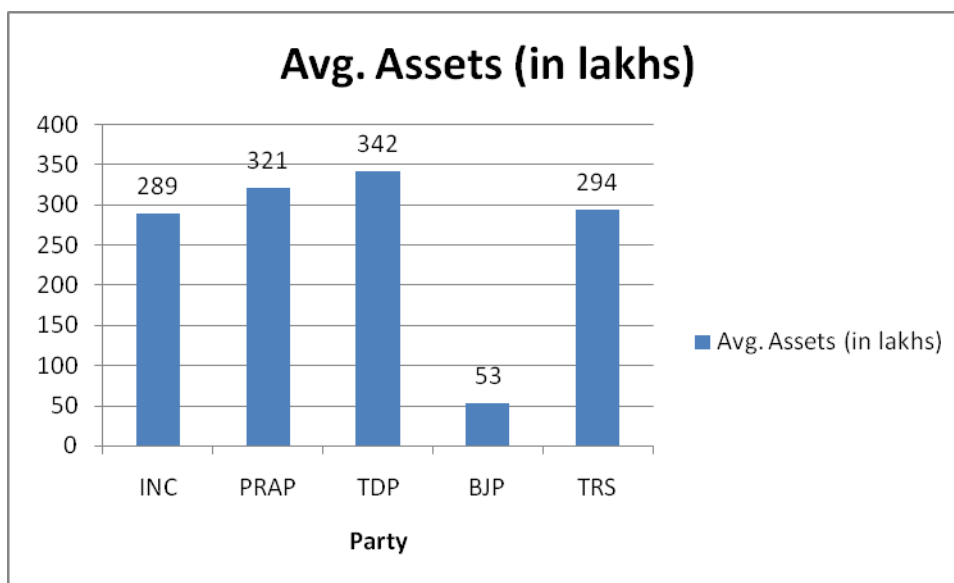


Figure: Average assets for candidates- party wise

Chances of winning based on assets

As can be seen from the table, the higher the assets the more are the chances of winning of a candidate. 38% of the candidates who declared assets of Rs 5 crore and above won. On the other hand only 3% of candidates with assets less than Rs 10 lakh won. The election results seemed to be highly influenced by the money power of the candidates.

Crorepati MLAs- party wise

48% MLAs of INC are crorepati where as for PRAP the corresponding figure is 88%. Over all 53% of the MLAs (147 out of 275 MLAs) in Assembly 2009 from Andhra Pradesh are crorepatis. Table below gives details of crorepati MLAs of major parties.

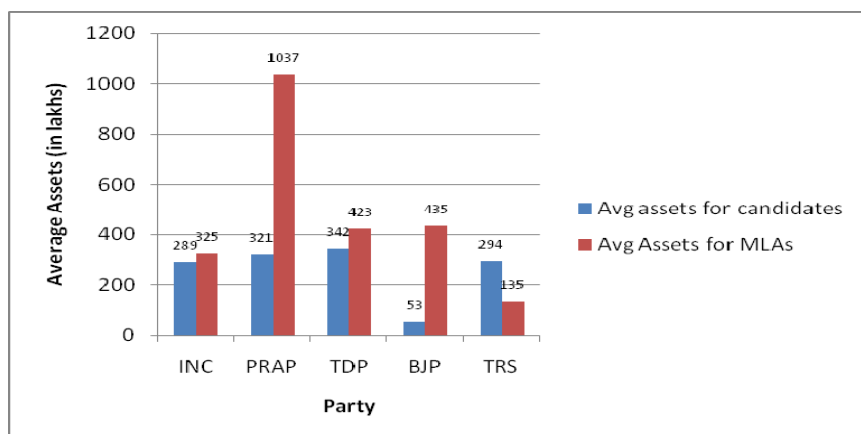


Figure: Comparison average assets for candidates & MLAs in Assembly 2009

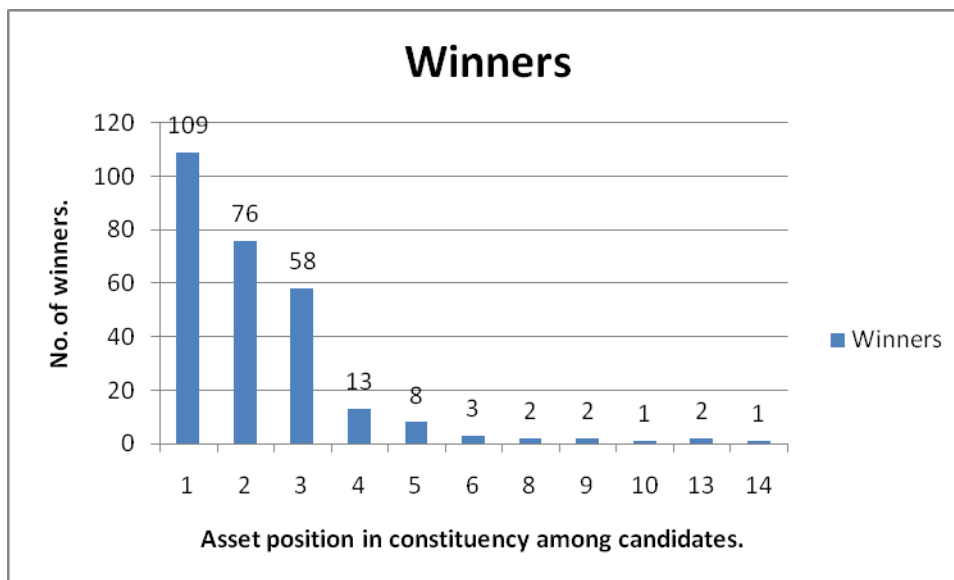


Figure: Asset position in constituency among candidates and winners
