Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Arunachal Pradesh Election Watch have analyzed the criminal, financial and other background details of 57 out of 60 sitting MLAs. In the current assembly 3 seats are vacant.

This analysis is based on the affidavits submitted by the candidates prior to the 2019 Assembly elections and by elections conducted thereafter.

The following 3 constituencies are vacant:








CRIMINAL BACKGROUND

- <u>MLAs with criminal cases</u>: Out of **57** sitting MLAs analysed, **9 (16%)** Sitting **MLAs** have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- MLAs with serious criminal cases: 7 (12%) Sitting MLAs have declared serious criminal cases.
- <u>Party wise sitting MLAs with criminal cases:</u> 6 (11%) out of 53 MLAs from BJP, 1 (100%) MLA from INC and 2 (100%) NPP MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- Party wise sitting MLAs with serious criminal cases: 4 (8%) out of 53 MLAs from BJP, 1 (100%) MLA from INC and 2 (100%) NPP MLAs have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.









FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

- Crorepati Sitting MLAs: Out of 57 sitting MLAs analysed , 53 (93%) are crorepatis.
- Party wise crorepati Sitting MLAs: 49 (92%) out of 53 MLAs from BJP, 2 (100%) out of 2 MLAs from NPP, 1 (100%) MLA from INC and 1 (100%) Independent MLA have declared assets valued more than Rs 1 crore.




Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Crorepati MLAs

- **Average assets**: The average of assets per sitting MLA is **Rs.19.56 crore**.
- <u>Party wise average assets</u>: The average assets per MLA for **53 BJP** MLAs analysed is **Rs.18.77 crores**, **1 INC** MLA analysed is **Rs.100.19 crores**, **2 NPP** MLAs analysed is **Rs.9.38 crores** and **1 Independent** MLA has average assets of **Rs.1.15 crores**.

OTHER BACKGROUND DETAILS

- Education Details of MLAs: 18(32%) MLAs have declared their educational qualification to be between 5th and 12th, while 37(65%) MLAs have declared having an educational qualification of graduate or above. There is one MLA who is Illiterate while 1 MLA is just literate.
- <u>Age details of MLAs:</u> 32 (56%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 31 and 50 years while 25 (44%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 51 and 80 years.
- Gender details of MLAs: Out of 57 MLAs analysed, 4 (7%) MLAs are women.




Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of education




Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of age groups


