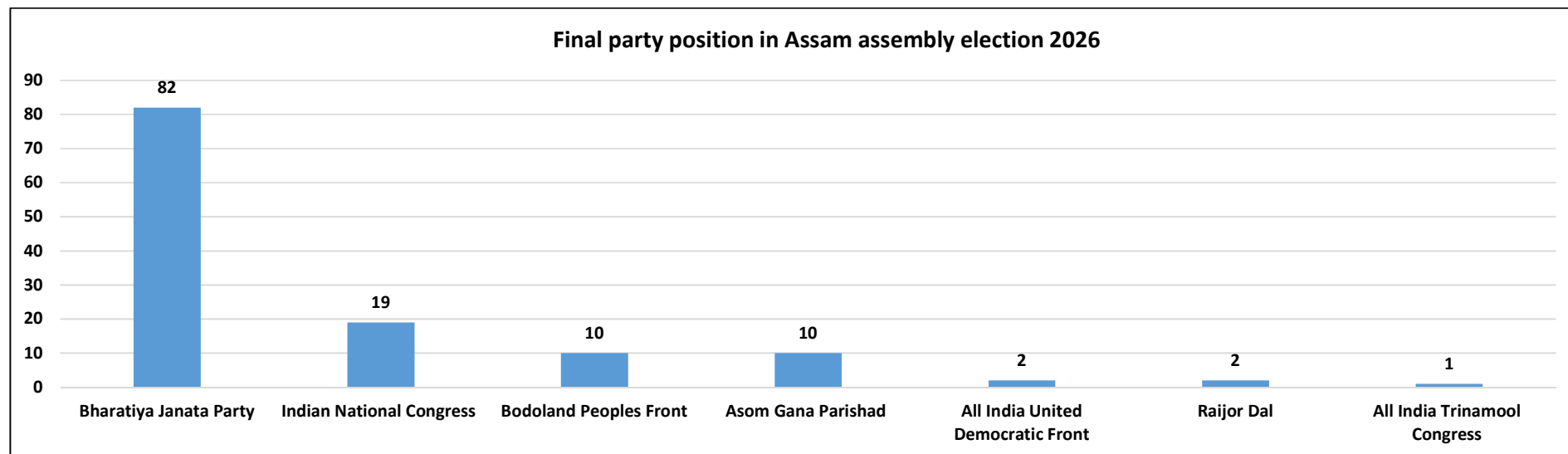


Figure: Final Party Position

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND

- **Winning Candidates with Criminal Cases:** Out of the 126 winning candidates analysed in 2026 **21(17%) winning candidates** have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of 126 MLAs analysed during Assam Assembly elections in 2021, **34(27%) MLAs** had declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Winning Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:** **19(15%)** winning candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves. Out of 126 MLAs analysed during Assam Assembly elections in 2021, **28 (22%) MLAs** had declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

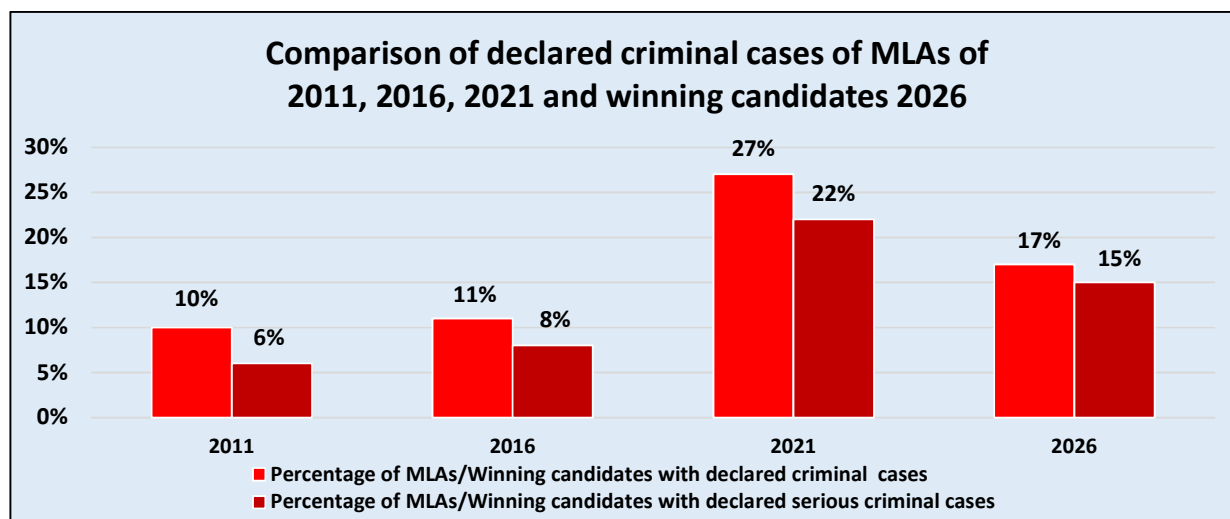
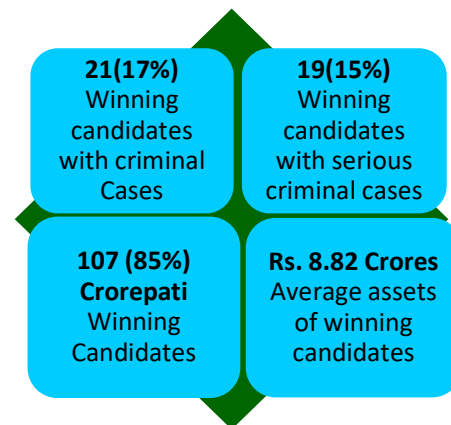


Figure: Comparison of declared criminal cases of MLAs of 2011, 2016, 2021 and winning candidates 2026

- Criteria for serious criminal cases**
1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
 2. If an offence is non-bailable, cognizable
 3. If it is an electoral offence
 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
 6. Offences that are mentioned under Act Section 8 Representation of the People
 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
 8. Crimes against women and children

- **Winning Candidates with Declared Cases Related to Attempt to Murder:** 3 winning candidates have declared cases related to **Attempt to murder (IPC Section-307)** and **(BNS Section-109)** against themselves.
- **Winning Candidates with Declared Cases Related to Crime Against Women:** 2 winning candidates have declared cases related to crime against women.
- **Party Wise Winning Candidates with Criminal Cases:** 7(9%) out of 82 winning candidates from **BJP**, 9(47%) out of 19 winning candidates from **INC**, 2 (100%) out of 2 winning candidates from **AIUDF**, 1(100%) out of 1 winning candidate from **AITC**, 1(50%) out of 2 winning candidate from **Raijor Dal** and 1 (10%) out of 10 winning candidates from **Asom Gana Parishad** have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits. It is noted that the **Bodoland Peoples Front** won 10 seats, and all its winning candidates have clean backgrounds with zero criminal cases.
- **Party Wise Winning Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:** 7(9%) out of 82 winning candidates from **BJP**, 7(37%) out of 19 winning candidates from **INC**, 2 (100%) out of 2 winning candidates from **AIUDF**, 1(100%) out of 1 winning candidate from **AITC**, 1(50%) out of 2 winning candidate from **Raijor Dal** and 1 (10%) out of 10 winning candidates from **Asom Gana Parishad** have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

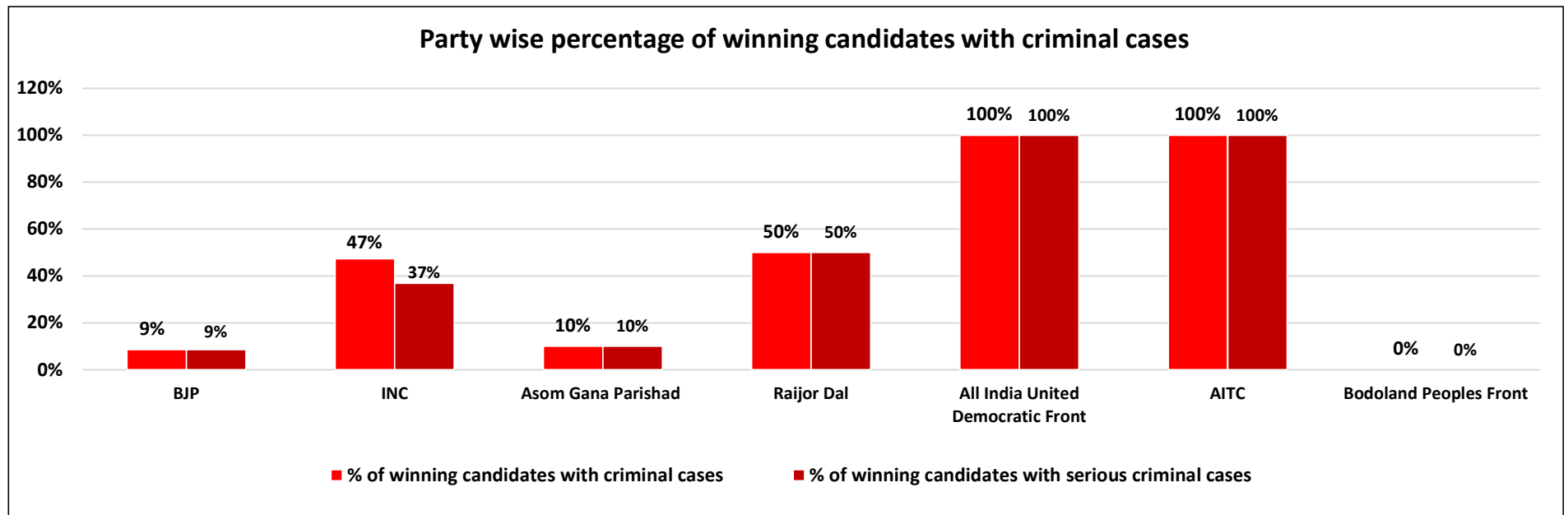


Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Winning Candidates with Criminal Cases

FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

- **Crorepati Winning Candidates:** Out of the 126 winning candidates analysed, 107 (85%) are crorepatis. Out of 126 MLAs analysed during Assam assembly elections 2021, 85(67%) MLAs were crorepati.

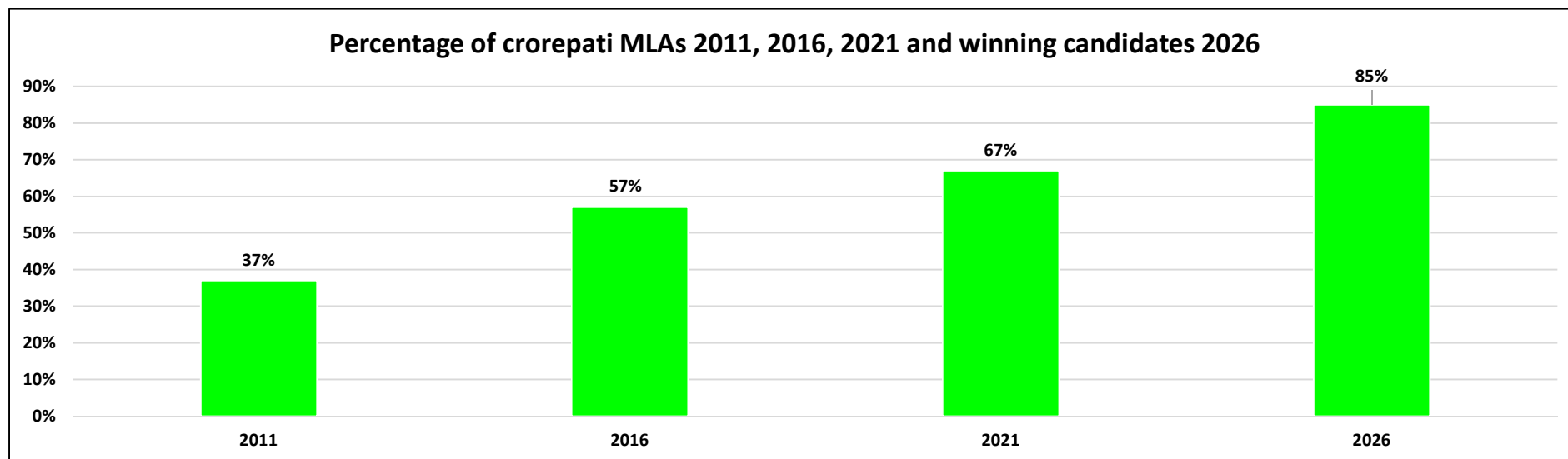


Figure: Percentage of Crorepati MLAs 2011, 2016, 2021 and Winning Candidates 2026

- **Party-wise crorepati winning candidates:** 74(90%) out of 85 winning candidates from BJP, 14(74%) out of 19 winning candidates from INC, 8 (80%) out of 10 winning candidates from Bodoland Peoples Front, 6(60%) out of 10 winning candidates from Asom Gana Parishad, 2(100%) out of 2 Winning candidates from Rajjor Dal, 2(100%) out of 2 Winning candidates from AIUDF and 1(100%) out of 1 winning candidate from AITC have declared assets worth more than Rs. 1 crore.

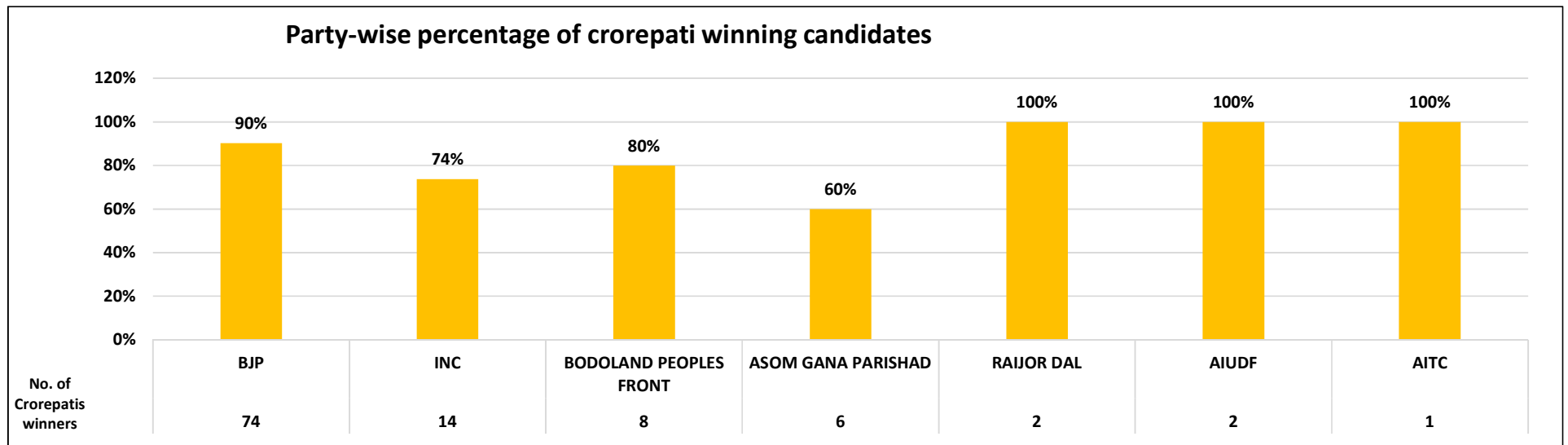


Figure: Party wise Percentage of Crorepati Winning Candidates

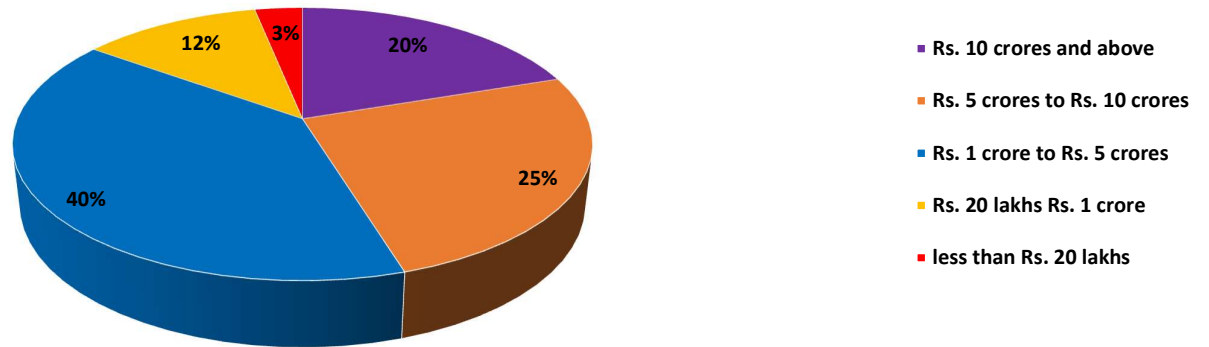


Figure: Share of Wealth among Winning Candidates

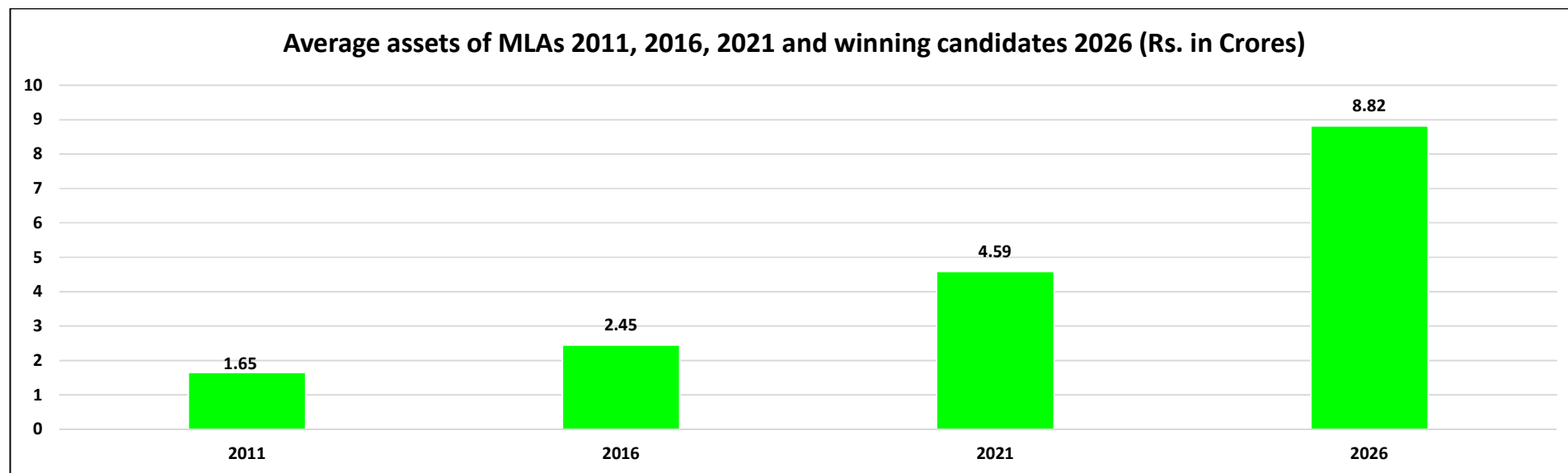


Figure: Comparison of Average Assets (Rs. in Crores) 2011, 2016, 2021 vs 2026

- **Party Wise Average Assets:** The average assets per winning candidate for **82 BJP** winning candidates is **Rs 7.50 Crores**, **19 INC** winning candidates have average assets of **Rs 6.51 Crores**, **10 Bodoland Peoples Front** Winning candidates have average assets worth **Rs 9.92 Crores**, **10 Asom Gana Parishad** winning candidates have average assets worth **Rs 2.81 Crore**, **2 AIUDF** winning candidates have average assets worth **Rs 117.77 Crore** and **2 Rajjor Dal** Winning candidates have average assets of **Rs. 1.54 crore**.

OTHER BACKGROUND DETAILS

- **Education Details of Winning Candidates:** 36(29%) winning candidates have declared their educational qualification to be between 10th pass and 12th pass while 89 (71%) winning candidates have declared having an educational qualification of **graduate and above**. 1 winning candidate is a Diploma holder.
- **Age Details of Winning Candidates:** 11(9%) winning candidates have declared their age to be between 25 and 40 years while 90 (71%) winning candidates have declared their age to be between 41 and 60 years. There are 25 (20%) winning candidates who have declared their age to be between 61 to 75 years.
- **Gender Details of Winning Candidates:** Out of 126 winning candidates analysed, 7 (6%) winning candidates are women. In 2021, out of 126 MLAs analysed, 6 (5%) MLAs were women.

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF ASSETS OF RE-ELECTED MLAS

- **Number of Re-Elected MLAs:** Number of re-elected MLAs analysed in the Assam assembly elections of 2026 is 63.
- **Average Assets of Re-Elected MLAs in 2021:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2021 was Rs 4.25 crores.
- **Average Assets of Re-Elected MLAs in 2026:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2026 is Rs 8.02 crores.
- **Average Growth in Assets of Re-Elected MLAs from 2021 to 2026:** The growth in average assets of re-elected MLAs is Rs 3.76 crores i.e. by 88%.

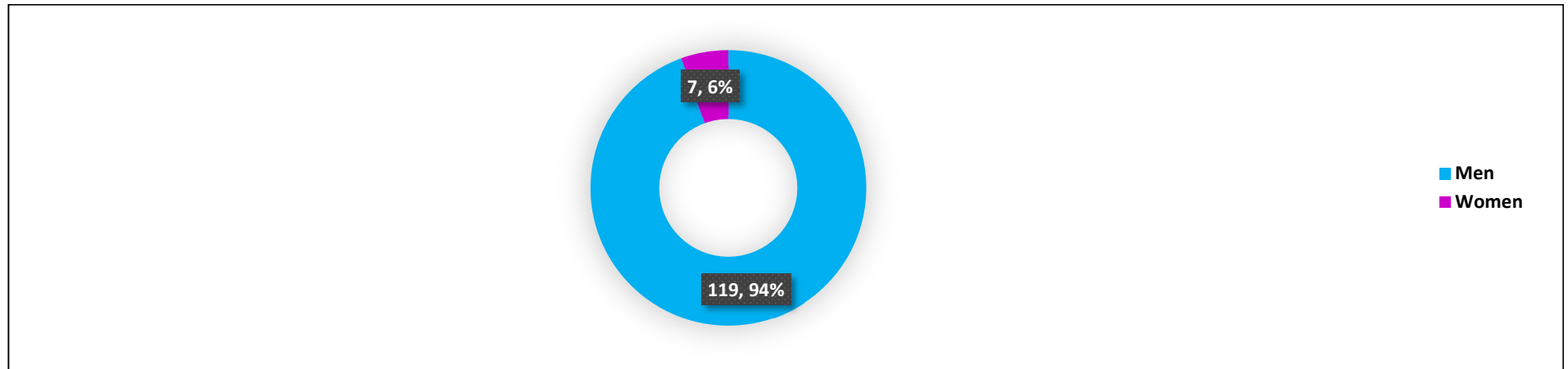
