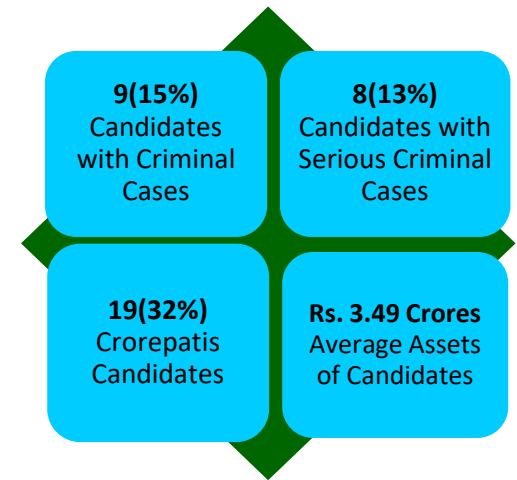

Summary and Highlights

Assam Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of 60 out of 61 candidates, who are contesting in the 5 constituencies in Assam Phase-II Lok Sabha elections 2024. One candidate namely **Ahad Uddin (Rashtriya Ulama Council)** contesting from **Karimganj** Constituency has not been analysed due to the unavailability of his clear and complete affidavit on the ECI website at the time of making this report.

Criminal Background

- **Candidates with Criminal Cases:** Out of 60 candidates analyzed, **9 (15%)** candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:** **8(13%)** candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.
