## Analysis of Newly Elected MLAs of 2012 Assembly Elections in Uttarakhand, U.P., Goa, Punjab and Manipur

- National Election Watch (NEW) groups in the five states of Uttarakhand, UP, Goa, Punjab and Manipur have analyzed the affidavits of 690 MLAs contesting in 2012 Assembly elections.
- 35% MLAs (242 out of 690 analyzed) have self declared pending criminal charges as per their affidavits in Uttarakhand, UP, Goa, Punjab and Manipur 2012 Assembly Elections.
- 114 MLAs out of these 690 analyzed have declared serious IPC charges like murder and attempt to murder charges against them.
- UP has the maximum percentage (47%) of MLAs with declared criminal cases against them.
- UP has the maximum percentage (24%) of MLAs with declared serious criminal cases against them.
- Mitrasen of Bikapur constituency in UP of SP has the maximum number of declared criminal cases (26) against him including 15 charges related to murder followed by Sushil Singh of Sakaldiha constituency in UP, an independent MLA with 16 declared criminal cases including 14 charges related to murder and Ram Veer Singh of Jastrana constituency in UP of SP with 18 declared criminal cases against him, including 8 charges related to murder, 1 charge of dacoity and 1 charge of robbery.
- A total of 457 MLAs (i.e. 66% of the total analyzed) are crorepatis.
- Goa has the maximum percentage (93%) of MLAs who are crorepatis, followed by Punjab with 86% of MLAs who are crorepatis.
- A total of 165 MLAs (24%) have declared that they have never filed Income Tax Returns (ITR).
- Manipur has the maximum percentage (43%) of MLAs who have not filed income tax, followed by Uttarakhand and UP with 27% of MLAs who not filed income tax.
- Out of the above 165 MLAs analyzed who have never filed IT returns, 67 have not even given their PAN details.

- Goa has the highest average asset increase (Rs 4.74 crores) of MLAs who recontested ie. from Rs 2.91 crores in 2007 to Rs 7.65 crores in 2012 (163% increase), followed by Punjab with average asset increase of Rs 3.43 crores (from Rs 5.73 crores in 2007 to Rs 9.17 crores in 2012, 60% increase) and UP with average asset increase of Rs Rs 2.12 crores (from Rs 98.05 lacs in 2007 to Rs 3.10 crores in 2012, 217% increase).
- Out of 690 newly elected MLAs, there only 8% women MLAs. Among the five states, Goa has only 1 out of 40 (2.5%) women MLA, followed by Manipur with 3 of 60 (5%) and Uttarakhand with 5 out of 70 (7%) women MLA.

**Delhi, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2012:** Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations, has been working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India. National Election Watch (NEW) groups in the five states of Uttarakhand, UP, Goa, Punjab and Manipur have analyzed the affidavits of 690 MLAs elected in 2012 elections. This report is based on the analysis of their affidavits.

The following pages give party- wise and MLA-wise analysis of criminal, financial, PAN availability, IT, gender and other background information of the newly elected MLAs.

### General Information

Uttarakhand Election Watch (UEW), UP Election Watch (UPEW), Goa Election Watch (GEW), Punjab Election Watch (PEW) and Manipur Election Watch (MEW) have analyzed a total of 690 MLAs elected in the Assembly Elections in Uttarakhand, UP, Goa, Punjab and Manipur.

## Analysis Based on Declared Criminal Cases

### Declared Criminal Cases against MLAs

- There are 242 MLAs out of the 690 analyzed, (i.e. about 35%) who have declared criminal cases against them as per their self sworn affidavits given to the Election Commission.
- Out of the 242 MLAs analyzed who have declared criminal cases, 114 have declared **serious** criminal cases like murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, robbery, extortion etc. on them.

A total of 457 MLAs out of 690 analyzed i.e 66% of the total number of MLAs (analyzed) elected in the 5 states are crorepatis. 93% of MLAs analyzed of Goa are crorepatis followed by 86% of MLAs of Punjab and 67% of MLAs of UP.

## Analysis of Income Tax and PAN details of MLAs in five Assembly Elections

- A total of 165 MLAs (24%) out of 690 MLAs analyzed have declared that they have never filed Income Tax Returns.
- Out of the above 165 MLAs who have never filed IT returns, 67 have not even given PAN details.

### State-wise MLAs who have not filed Income Tax Returns (ITR)

Out of 690 MLAs analyzed, 165 MLAs (24%) have declared that they not filed Income Tax Returns. They include 43% of MLAs from Manipur followed by 27% each from UP and Uttarakhand, 10% MLAs from Punjab and 3% MLAs from Goa.


