Lok Sabha Elections, 2024 - Chandigarh

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 19 candidates, who are contesting in Chandigarh Lok Sabha Election 2024.

<u>Criminal Background, Financial, Education, Gender and other details of Candidates</u>

- There are **3(16%)** candidates who have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of these, **2(11%)** have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- 9(47%) candidates are crorepatis.
- The average assets per candidate contesting in the **Chandigarh** for Lok Sabha 2024 is **Rs. 8.34 crores**.
- Out of 19 candidates, 2(11%) female candidates are contesting.
