Chhattisgarh Lok Sabha Elections, 2024

Chhattisgarh Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 11 candidates, who are contesting in Chhattisgarh Phase-I Lok Sabha Election 2024.

Criminal Background, Financial, Education, Gender and other details of Candidates

- None of the candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- 2(18%) candidates are crorepatis.
- The average assets per candidate contesting in the Bastar (ST) Constituency in Chhattisgarh Phase-I Lok Sabha elections 2024 is Rs. 64.55 Lakhs .
- There are **3** candidates who have declared liabilities.
- There is no woman candidate contesting.
