Jammu & Kashmir Lok Sabha Elections, 2024

Jammu & Kashmir Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 24 candidates, who are contesting in the Srinagar constituency in Jammu & Kashmir Phase-IV Lok Sabha elections 2024.

<u>Criminal Background, Financial, Education, Gender and other details of Candidates</u>

- There are 4(17%) candidates who have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of these, 2(8%) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- 8(33%) candidates are crorepatis.
- There are 10 candidates who have declared liabilities.
- Out of 24 candidates, 2(8%) female candidates are contesting.


