## Jammu & Kashmir Lok Sabha Elections, 2024

Jammu & Kashmir Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 22 candidates, who are contesting in the Baramulla constituency in Jammu & Kashmir Phase-V Lok Sabha elections 2024.

### Criminal Background, Financial, Education, Gender and other details of Candidates

- There are **2(9%)** candidates who have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- **4(18%)** candidates are crorepatis.
- There are **5** candidates who have declared liabilities.
- Out of **22** candidates, **2(9%)** female candidates are contesting.

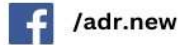
