Lok Sabha Elections, 2024 - Sikkim

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 14 candidates, who are contesting in Sikkim Lok Sabha Election 2024.

<u>Criminal Background, Financial, Education, Gender and other details of Candidates</u>

- None of the candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- 6(43%) candidates are crorepatis.
- The average assets per candidate contesting in the Sikkim for Lok Sabha Elections 2024 is **Rs. 3.16 crores**.
- There are **3** candidates who have declared liabilities.
- Only 1 female candidate is contesting in the Sikkim for Lok Sabha election 2024.
