- There is no woman candidate contesting.



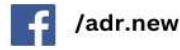
