Analysis Based on Declared Criminal Cases

- There are 57 MLAs out of the 76 analysed, (i.e about 75%) who have declared criminal cases against them as per their self-sworn affidavits given to the election commission.
- Out of the 57 MLAs analysed who have declared criminal cases, 24 have declared serious criminal cases like murder, kidnapping, crimes against women etc.
