
Summary and Highlights

Jharkhand Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 45 candidates, who are contesting in the following 4 constituencies in the Jharkhand Phase-I in Lok sabha phase IV elections 2024.

Criminal Background

- Candidates with Criminal Cases: Out of 45 candidates analyzed, 13 (29%) candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases: 9(20%) candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.



Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- 6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption
- Crimes against women.
