Criminal Background

- <u>Candidates with Criminal Cases</u>: Out of 54 candidates analyzed, 18 (33%) candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- <u>Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases</u>: 9(17%) candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
