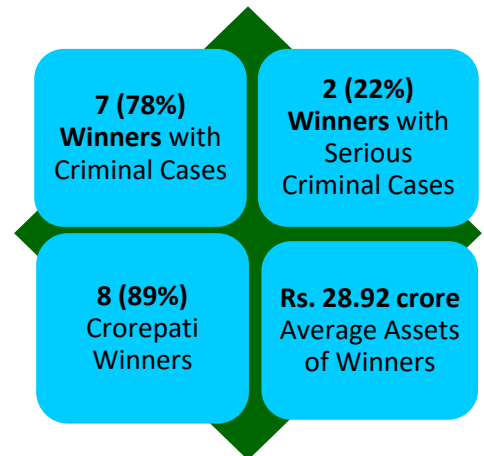

Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Maharashtra Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 9 winners who had contested in the **Maharashtra Legislative Council Biennial Elections in May 2020**. All candidates elected by MLAs have won unopposed.

Criminal Background

- **Winners with declared Criminal Cases:** 7 (78%) out of 9 analyzed winners have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Winners with declared Serious Criminal Cases:** 2 (22%) out of 9 analyzed winners have declared serious criminal cases against themselves like Rape, Murder, attempt to murder, etc.



Financial Background

- **Crorepati Winners:** Out of the 9 analyzed winners, 8 (89%) are crorepatis.

3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.
