EC's directions (in its letters dated 6th Mar'20 & 10th Oct'18) in compliance with SC orders dated 25th September, 2018 and 13th February, 2020 on Publication of Criminal Cases by Candidates and Political Parties including recording of reasons for selection.

ECI's Letter dated 6th March, 2020 in compliance with Supreme Court directions dated 13th February, 2020:

- 1) It is mandatory for **political parties** at the Central and State election level to upload on their **website detailed information regarding candidates with pending criminal cases including the nature of the offences, relevant particulars like whether charges have been framed, the concerned Court, the case number etc.**
- 2) **Political parties** will also have to give **reasons for such selection** and **why other individuals without criminal antecedents could not be selected as candidates.**
- 3) The reasons as to selection shall be with reference to the **qualifications, achievements and merit of the candidate concerned**, and not mere **“winnability”** at the polls.
- 4) This information shall also be published in: (a) **One local vernacular newspaper** and **one national newspaper**; (b) On the **official social media platforms** of the political party, including **Facebook & Twitter**.
- 5) These details shall be published within **48 hours of the selection of the candidate or not less than two weeks before the first date for filing of nominations**, whichever is earlier.
- 6) The **political party** concerned shall then submit **a report of compliance with these directions with the Election Commission within 72 hours** of the selection of the said candidate.
- 7) If a **political party fails to submit such a compliance report** with the Election Commission, **the Election Commission shall bring such non-compliance by the political party concerned to the notice of the Supreme Court as being in contempt of this Court's orders/directions.**

For Candidates:

1. Each contesting candidate shall fill up the form as provided by the Election Commission and the form **must contain all the particulars as required** therein.
2. It shall state, **in bold letters, with regard to the criminal cases pending against the candidate.**
3. If a candidate is contesting an election on the ticket of a particular party, **he/she is required to inform the party about the criminal cases pending against him/her.**

For Political Parties:

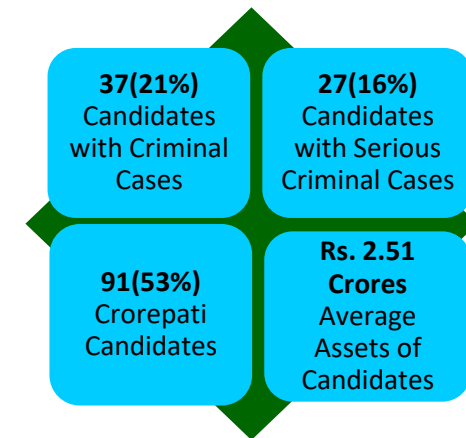
1. The concerned political party shall be **obligated to put up on its website the aforesaid information pertaining to candidates having criminal antecedents.**

Both Political Party and Candidates.

1. It is mandatory for **political parties and candidates** with criminal antecedents to publish the declaration **atleast on three different dates from the date following the last date of withdrawal of candidatures and upto two days before the date of poll.** The matter should be published in font size of at least 12 and should be placed suitably in newspapers. In case of **declaration in TV Channels, the same should be completed before a period of 48 hours ending with hours fixed for conclusion of poll.** There is a format provided by ECI for such a declaration by the candidates and political parties.
2. In case of non compliance of the direction by the **candidate/political parties, the returning officers will give a written reminder** to them and in the event of non compliance till the end of the elections, **the returning officer will report to the state's Chief Electoral Officer who will intimate ECI. ECI will take a final decision in the matter.** The standard format for such a reminder to the candidates and political parties is also annexed in the letter.
3. **All political parties; recognized parties and registered unrecognized parties shall submit a report to the CEO of the concerned state stating that they have fulfilled the requirements of the directions and enclosing herewith the paper cuttings containing the directions.** This shall be done within 30 days of the completion of elections. Thereafter, within the next 15 days, the CEO should submit a report to the ECI confirming compliance and pointing out cases of defaulters.

Summary and Highlights

The **Manipur Election Watch** and **Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR)** have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all **173** candidates, who are contesting in the **Manipur Assembly Elections Phase I** in the following **38** constituencies:

Criminal Background

- **Candidates with Criminal Cases:** Out of 173 candidates analyzed, 37 (21%) candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:** 27(16%) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

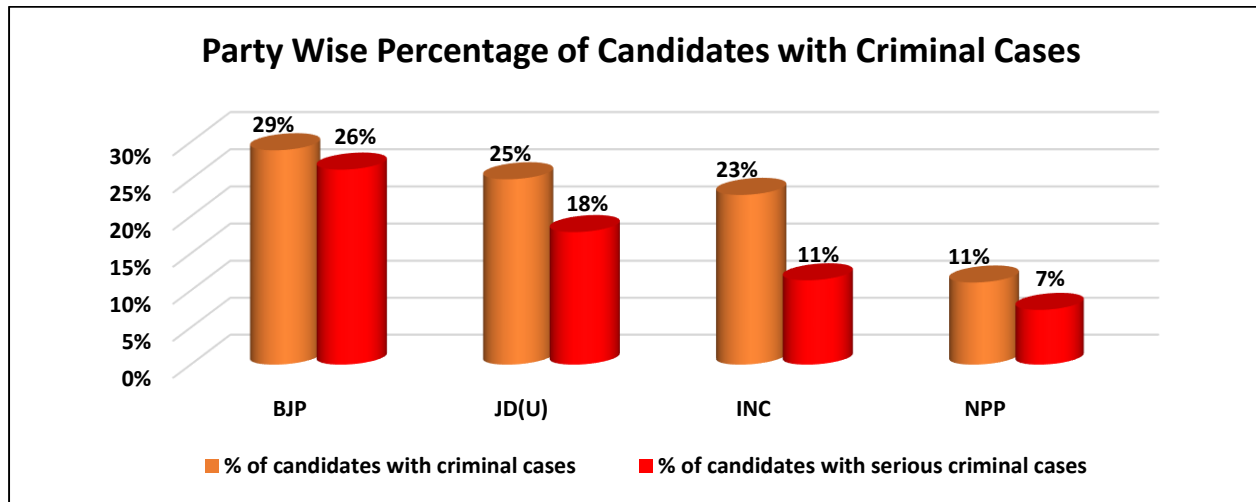


Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Candidates with Criminal Cases

- **Party wise Candidates with Criminal Cases:** Among the major parties, 11(29%) out of 38 candidates analysed from **BJP**, 7(25%) out of 28 candidates analysed from **JD(U)**, 8 (23%) out of 35 candidates analysed from **INC** and 3 (11%) out of 27 candidates analysed from **NPP** have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- **Party wise Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:** Among the major parties, 10(26%) out of 38 candidates analysed from **BJP**, 5(18%) out of 28 candidates analysed from **JD(U)**, 4 (11%) out of 35 candidates analysed from **INC** and 2 (7%) out of 27 candidates analysed from **NPP** have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- **Candidates with declared cases related to crime against women:** 2 candidates have declared cases related to crime against women.
- **Candidates with declared cases related to murder:** 2 candidates have declared cases related to **murder (IPC Section-302)** against themselves.

- Criteria for serious criminal cases*
1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
 2. If an offence is non-bailable
 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
 6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
 8. Crimes against women.

- **Candidates with declared cases related to attempt to murder:** 6 candidates have declared cases related to **Attempt to murder (IPC Section-307)** against themselves.
- **Red Alert Constituencies*:** **3(8%) out of 38** constituencies are Red alert constituencies. Red alert constituencies are those where 3 or more contesting candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- The **directions** of the **Supreme Court** have had **no effect on the political parties in selection of candidates** in **Phase I** of the **Manipur Assembly Elections** as they have again followed their old practice of **giving tickets to around 21% candidates with criminal cases**. All major parties contesting in **Manipur phase I** elections have given tickets to **11 % to 29 %** candidates who have declared criminal cases against themselves. The Supreme Court in its directions dated 13th February, 2020 had **specifically instructed political parties** to give **reasons for such selection** and **why other individuals without criminal antecedents could not be selected as candidates**. As per these mandatory guidelines, the reasons for such selection has to be with reference to **qualifications, achievements and merit of the candidate concerned**. **During the recent 6 State Assembly elections held in 2020-21**, it was observed that **political parties gave unfounded and baseless** reasons like popularity of the person, does good social work, cases are politically motivated etc. These are **not sound and cogent reasons** for fielding candidates with tainted backgrounds. This data clearly shows that **political parties have no interest in reforming the electoral system** and our democracy will continue to suffer at the hands of lawbreakers who become lawmakers.

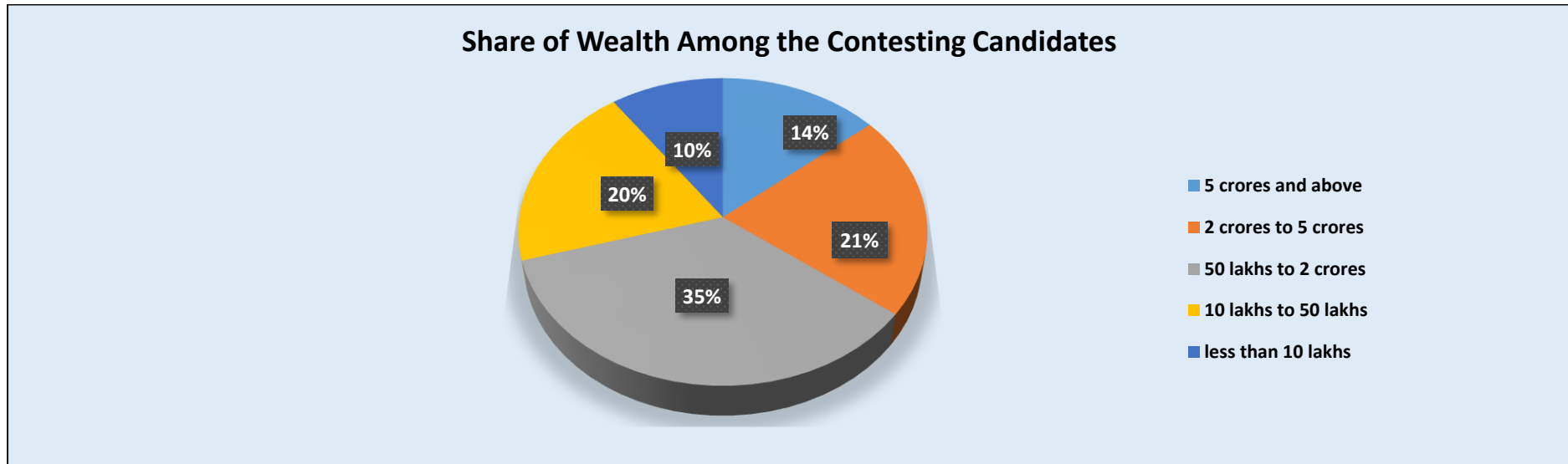


Figure: Share of Wealth among the Contesting Candidates

- **Crorepati Candidates:** Out of the **173** candidates, **91(53%)** are crorepatis.
- **Party wise Crorepati Candidates:** The role of money power in our elections is evident from the fact that all major political parties give tickets to wealthy candidates. Among the major parties **21(78%)** out of 27 candidates analysed from **NPP**, **27(71%)** out of 38 candidates analysed from **BJP**, **18(51%)** out of 35 candidates analysed from **INC** and **14(50%)** out of 28 candidates analysed from **JD(U)** have declared assets valued more than **Rs 1 crore**.

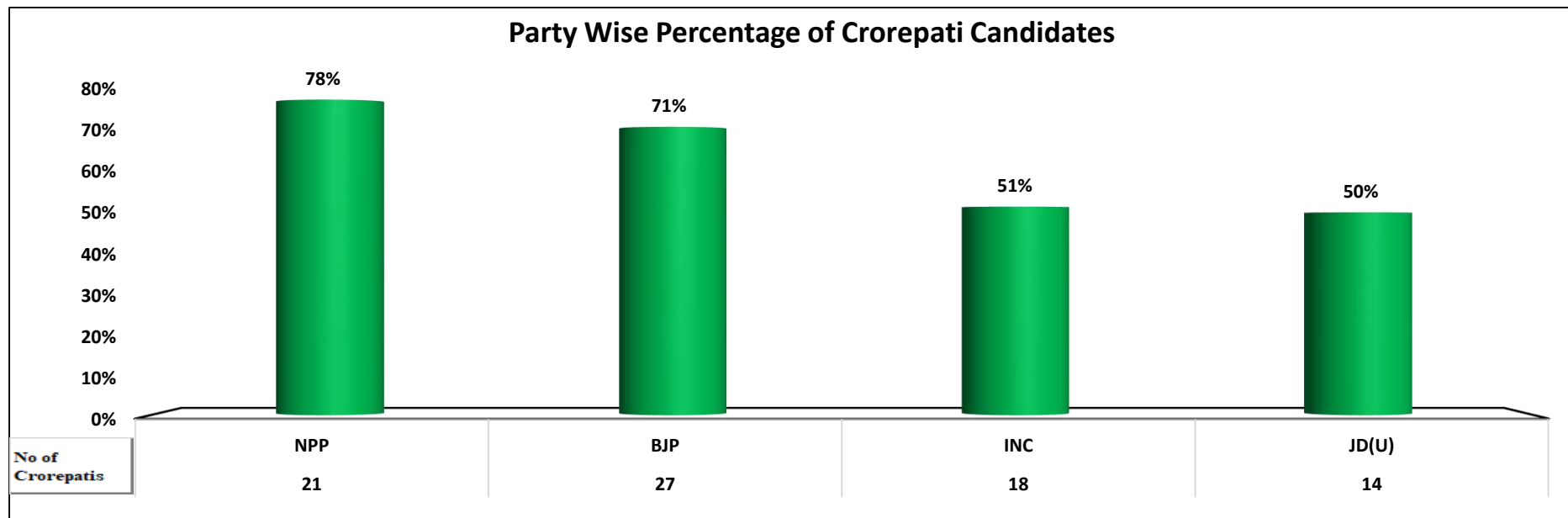


Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Crorepati Candidates

- **Average assets:** The average of assets per candidate contesting in the **Manipur Assembly Elections 2022 Phase I** is **Rs 2.51 Crores**.

- **Party wise average assets:** Among major parties, the average assets per candidate for **27 NPP** candidates analysed is **Rs. 3.48 Crores**, **38 BJP** candidates analysed is **Rs 2.84 Crores**, **28 JD(U)** candidates have average assets of **Rs 2.67 Crores** and **35 INC candidates** have average assets worth **Rs. 1.93 Crores**.
- **High asset candidates:** The details of top **3** candidates with highest declared assets, contesting in the **Manipur Assembly Elections Phase I** are given below:

Other Background Details

- **Education details of candidates:** 37(21%) candidates have declared their educational qualifications to be between 5th and 12th standard while 133(77%) candidates have declared having an educational qualification of **graduate or above**. 3 candidates are **Diploma holders**.
- **Age details of candidates:** 23(13%) candidates have declared their age to be between 25 to 40 years while 115 (66%) candidates have declared their age to be between 41 to 60 years. There are 33(19 %) candidates who have declared their age to be between 61 to 80 years and 2 candidates have declared they are **more than 80** years old.
- **Gender details of candidates:** 15(9%) female candidates are contesting in **the Manipur assembly election 2022 Phase I**.

Recommendations of ADR:

- To remedy the existing problem of criminalization is to immediately act upon the plausible solutions offered by various committees, civil society and citizens. Supreme Court of India being the ultimate custodian of “Justice and Rule of Law” should reprimand political parties and politicians for their complete lack of will, reprehensible predilection and absence of required laws.
- Permanent disqualification of candidates convicted for heinous crimes like murder, rape, smuggling, dacoity, kidnapping etc.
- Disqualification of persons from contesting elections to the public offices against whom charges have been framed for having committed serious criminal offences punishable by imprisonment of at least 5 years, and the case is filed at least 6 months prior to the election in question.
- Cancellation of tax exemptions given to the political parties who field such tainted candidates.
- Bringing political parties under the Right to Information Act.
- De-register and de-recognise any political party if it knowingly puts up a candidate with a tainted background.
- Political party should annually file the information on criminal antecedents of their Office Bearers and make such records available to the public, including NIL records.
- Disqualification of candidates furnishing false information in the election affidavit (Form 26).
- Ensure trial of cases in which the politicians are accused to be concluded in a time bound manner.
- Implementation of SC judgment dated 23rd September, 2013 (i.e provision of NOTA buttons on the *EVMs*) in its *letter and spirit* by ensuring a) if NOTA gets more votes than any of the candidates, none of the candidates should be declared elected, and a fresh election should be held; b) in the fresh election, none of the candidates in the earlier election, in which NOTA got the highest number of votes, should be allowed to contest.
- Implementation of the **25th September, 2018** and **13th February, 2020 SC** orders on '*publication of criminal cases against candidates selected by political parties along with reasons for such selection*' in its *letter and spirit* by directing the Election Commission of India a) **to list out names of such tainted candidates selected by the political parties along with such reasons for such selection C8 including diligent publication of reasons in newspapers, T.V channels, party website etc,** b) **strict and constant reminders by ROs to the defaulters,** c) **list needs to be religiously prepared and submitted to the Supreme Court after every election,** d) **uploading of this list on ECI's website for public inspection,** e) **a suitably heavy financial penalty levied on political parties for making insufficient disclosures, invalid and common reasons, selection of candidates based on winnability and** f) **Officer in-charge of a political party pertaining to submission of a compliance report should also be held accountable for such a breach.**

- The Election Commission of India and all State Election Commissions *should make it* mandatory in all elections; Parliamentary, Assembly and Local Body elections to carry **display boards outside each and every polling booth showing a summarised version of candidates' affidavits**. The polling booths should essentially display details of *candidate's criminal records, assets and liabilities and education qualification*.
- The Election Commission of India under its 'Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation' (SVEEP) as well as through other national campaigns on voter awareness held before every election should inform and aware the voters that **(i) taking and giving cash or gifts/freebies for votes is a criminal offense, (ii) such instances should be brought to the notice of the ECI through its web application, (iii) inform voters that information on criminal records of candidates is available on the ECI website, outside polling booths and other sources that the ECI may use.**
- Political parties in India should be required to announce/publish the list of candidates contesting elections **at least 3 months prior to elections.**
- Role of money and muscle power is evident from the fact that all major political parties in **Manipur phase I** elections have fielded **50% to 78% candidates who are crorepatis and 11% to 29 % candidates who have declared criminal cases** against themselves. This close and alarming nexus between money power and muscle power has got so ingrained in our electoral system that the citizens are left hostage to the current situation. **18 % of the population of Manipur is already below the poverty line as per the NFHS 2015-16 report of NITI Aayog published in 2021.** Money and muscle power hurt the principles of '*free and fair elections*', '*participatory democracy*' and '*level playing field*'. The present circumstances therefore demand **an extensive deliberation by the voters so that sanctity of elections is not ridiculed by tenacious entry of tainted candidates and candidates with abnormal multiplication of assets.**

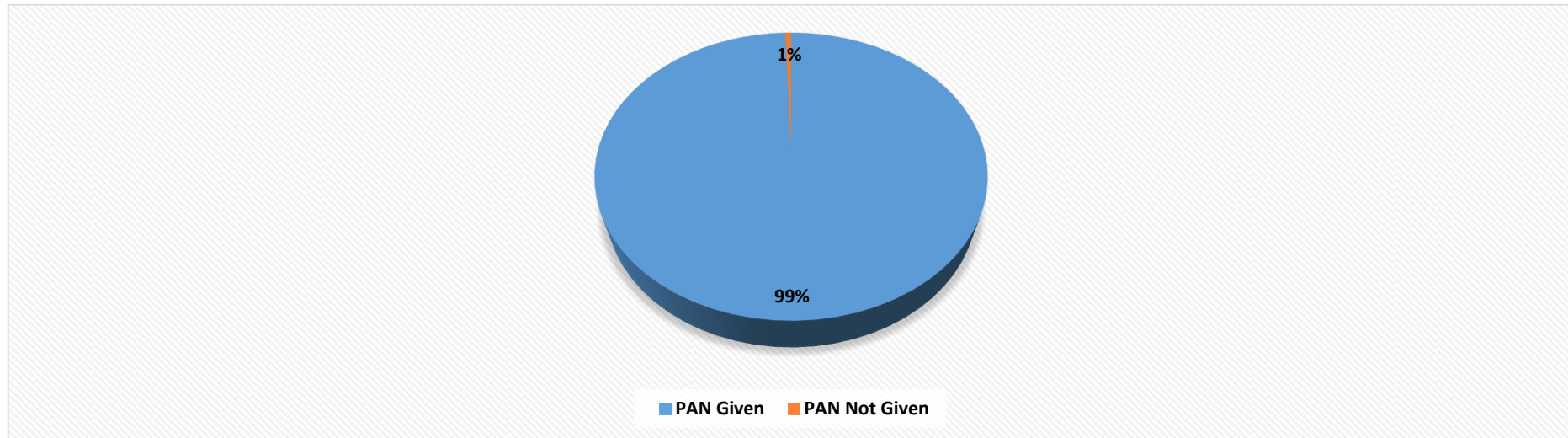

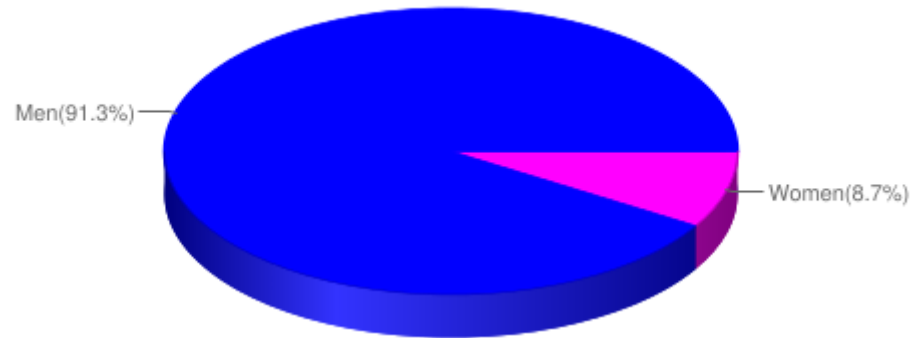

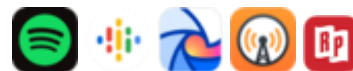
