

Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Meghalaya Election Watch have analyzed the criminal, financial and other background details of **41** out of **60** sitting MLAs. In current assembly 19 seats are vacant.

This analysis is based on the affidavits submitted by the candidates prior to the 2018 Assembly elections and bye elections conducted thereafter.

- Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- If an offence is non-bailable
- If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- Offence related to loss to exchequer
- Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- Crimes against women.

FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

- **Crorepati MLAs:** Out of **41** sitting MLAs analysed, **29 (71%)** are crorepatis.
- **Party wise crorepati MLAs:** **14 (70%)** out of 20 MLAs from **NPP**, **5 (63%)** out of 8 MLAs from **AITC**, **6 (75%)** out of 8 MLAs from **United Democratic Party**, **3 (100%)** out of 3 MLAs from **BJP** and **1 (50%)** out of 2 from **Peoples Democratic Front** MLAs have declared assets valued more than Rs 1 crore.




Figure: Party Wise Percentage of Crorepati MLAs




Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of education




Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of age groups


