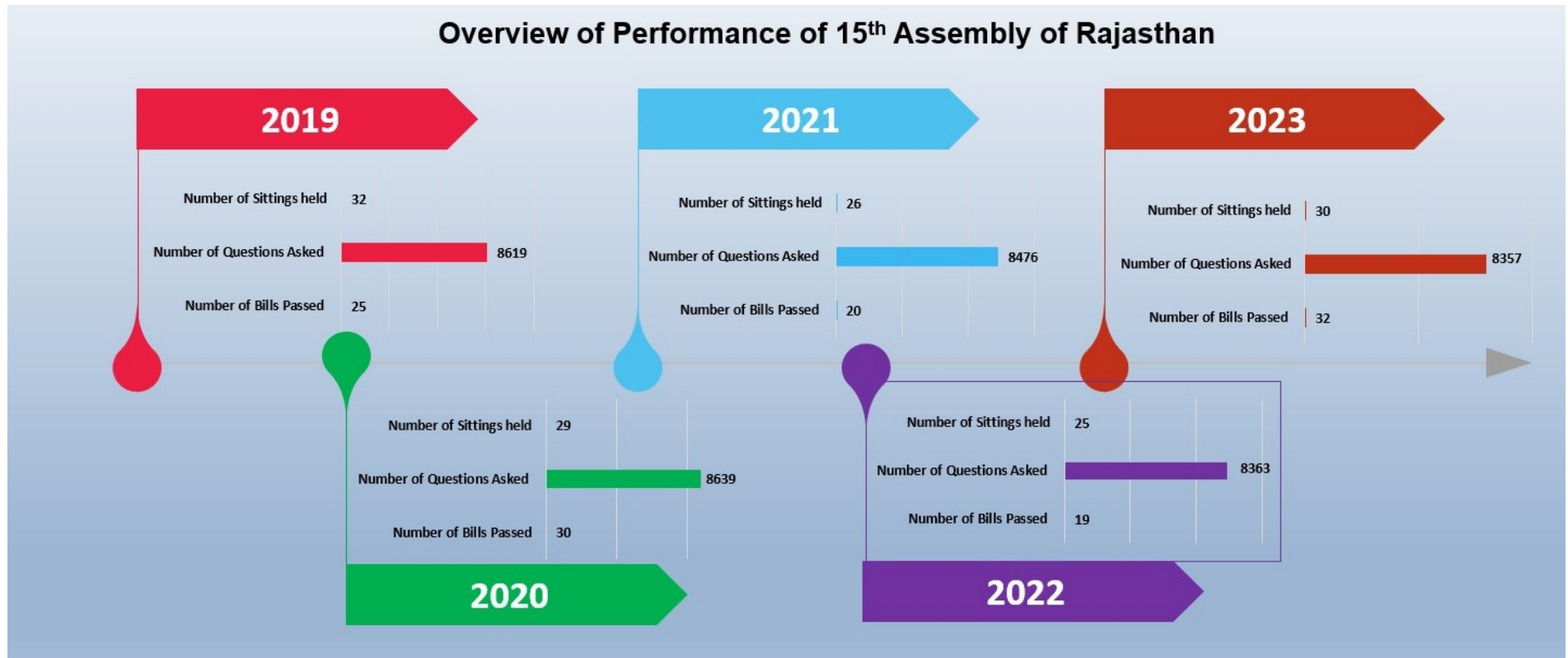

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and **Rajasthan Election Watch (REW)** had filed RTI applications to the Rajasthan Assembly Secretariat asking for the information pertaining to the performance of the MLAs and the Legislative Assembly. This report is based on information available on the website of Rajasthan Legislative Assembly and from the RTI responses received from Rajasthan Assembly Secretariat.

There are 200 seats in Rajasthan Assembly, however this report also includes the analysis for the MLAs who have resigned or got elected through bye-elections.



Analysis of Number of Sittings in Each Session of Rajasthan Legislative Assembly

- On an average, Rajasthan State Assembly sat for **29** days per year.
- The longest sessions were the 7th session (9th February, 2022 to 23rd September 2022) and 8th session (23rd January, 2023 to 2nd August, 2023). Both had 30 sittings.

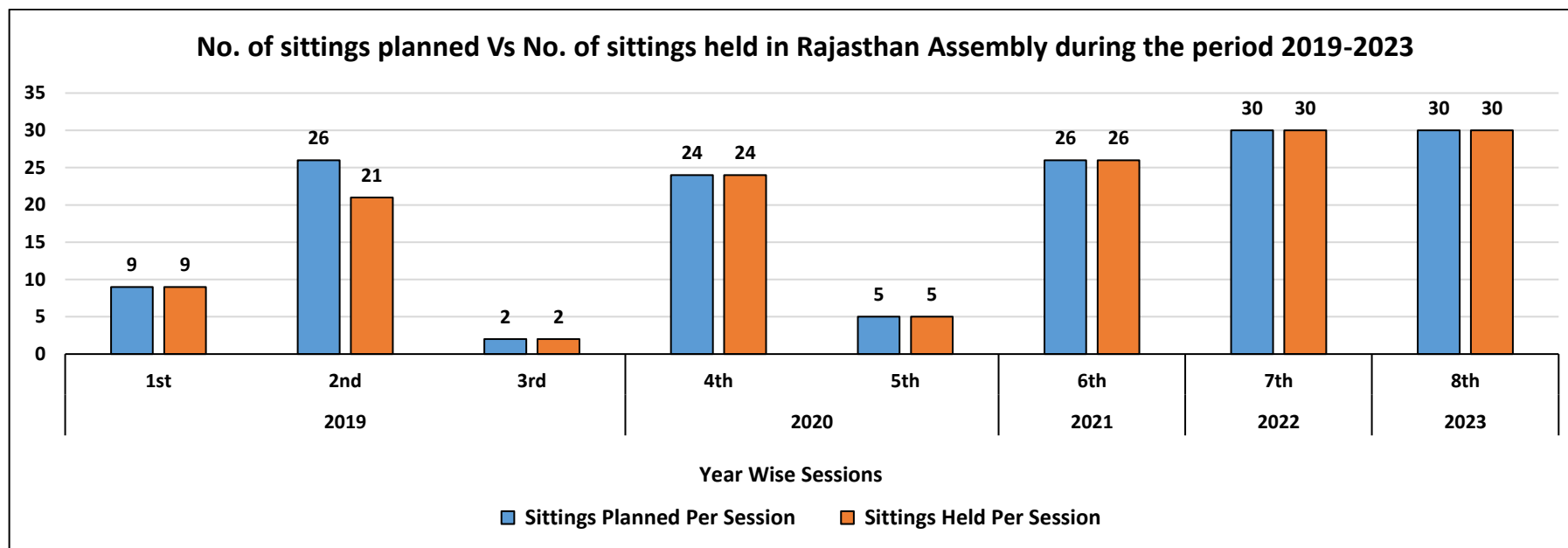


Figure: No. of sittings planned vs No. of sittings held in Rajasthan Assembly during the period 2019-2023

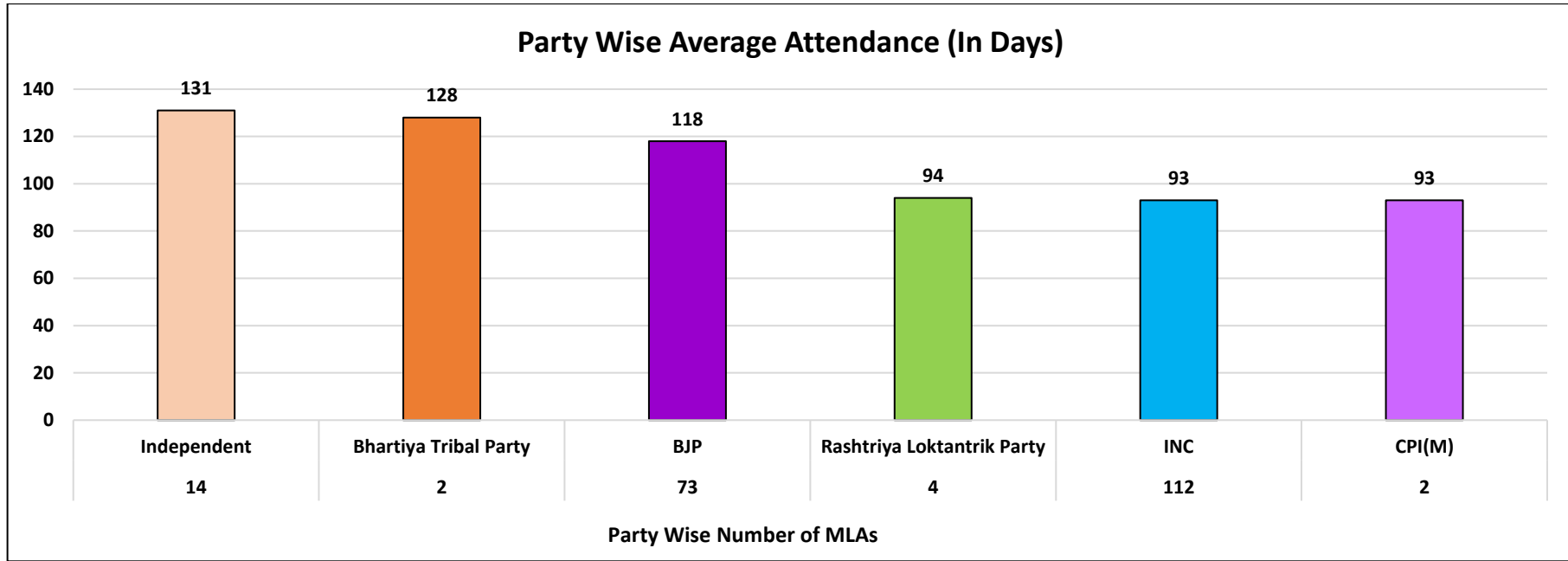


Figure: Party Wise Average Attendance

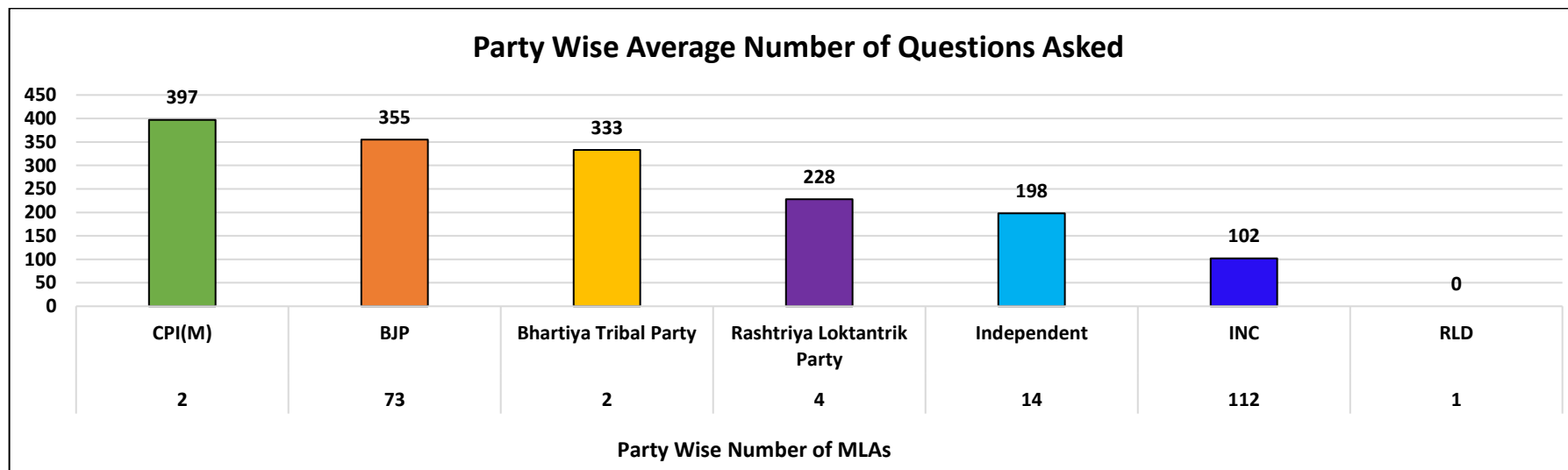


Figure: Party Wise Average Number of Questions Asked

- Highest number of Questions were related to Medicine and Health, Education and Energy.

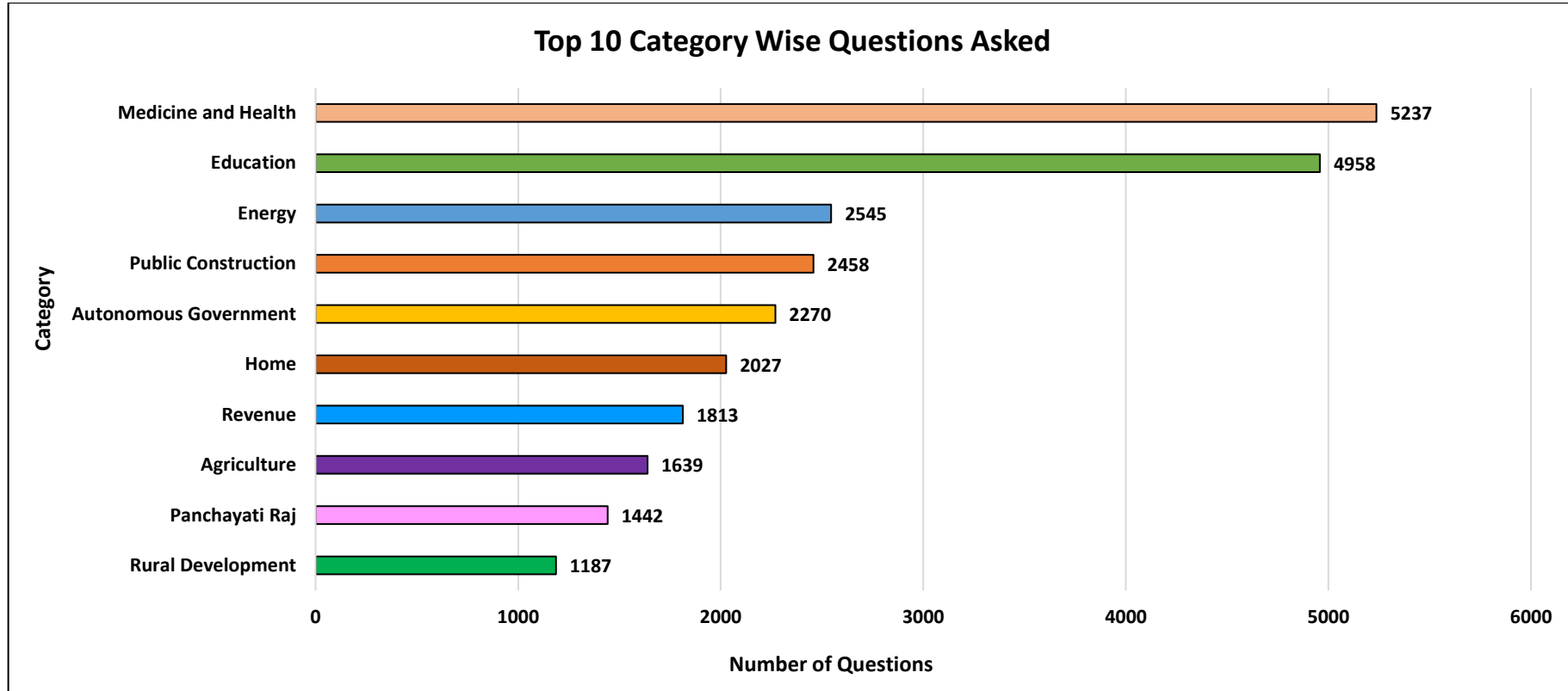


Figure: Top 10 - Category Wise Questions Asked

- **2** Bills were withdrawn and there was no discussion on **6** Bills.

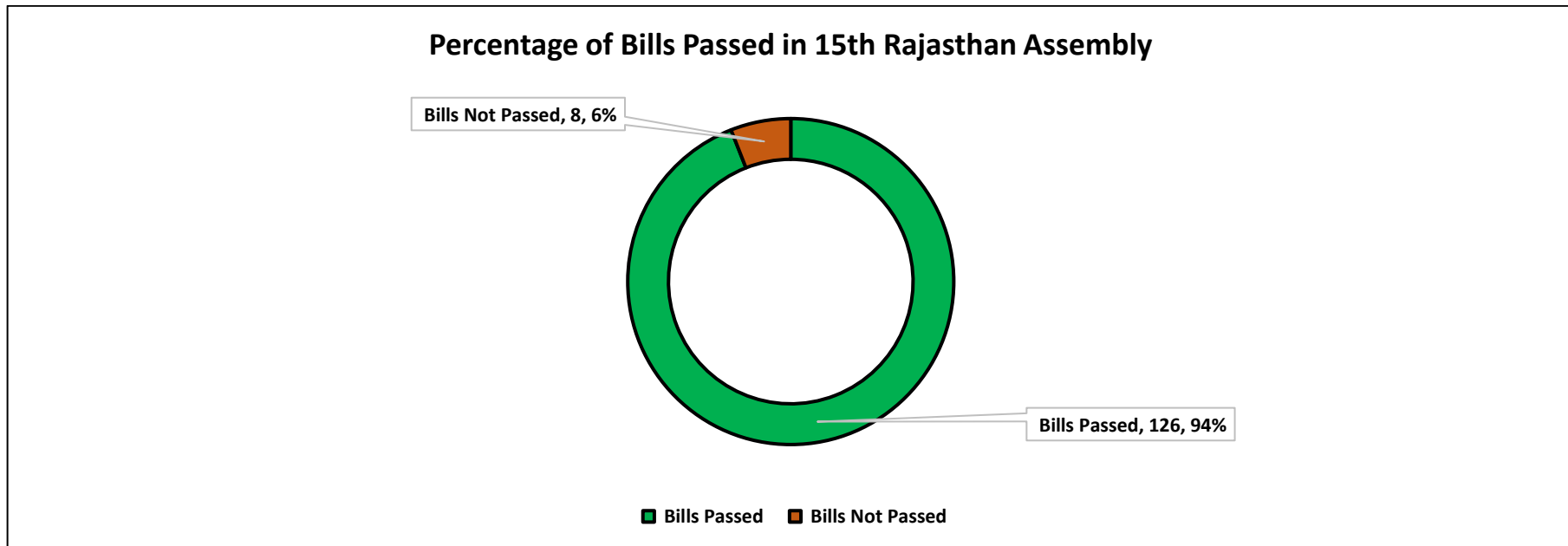


Figure: Percentage of Bills Passed in 15th Rajasthan Assembly
