

JHARKHAND TEN YEARS OF ELECTION WATCH (SINCE 2004) **REPORT ON ELECTIONS, CRIME AND MONEY**

SUMMARY AND HIGHLIGHTS

Following are the highlights that emerge from the analysis carried out by Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW)-

- **Total number of candidates analyzed:** A total of **1761 candidates** who have contested either Parliamentary or State assembly elections since 2004 have been analyzed by ADR and NEW.
- **Total number of MPs/MLAs analyzed:** A total of **189 MPs/MLAs** who have either held seats since 2004 either in Parliamentary or State assembly elections since 2004 have been analyzed by ADR and NEW.

Criminal

- **Candidates with criminal cases:** A total of **525** out of these 1761 (**30%**) candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Candidates with serious criminal cases:** **260 (15%)** out of the 1761 candidates analyzed have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
- **MPs/MLAs with criminal cases:** Out of 189 MPs/MLAs analyzed since 2004, **104** or **56%** have declared criminal cases against themselves and **48** or **25%** have serious criminal charges. **JMM** has **42%**, **RJD** has **36%**, **INC** has **26%** and **BJP** has **11%** MPs/MLAs with serious criminal charges.

Financial

- **Average assets of candidates who have contested elections (2004-2013):** The average assets of all candidates (1762) analyzed since 2004 is **Rs. 46.22 Lakhs**.
- **Average assets of MPs/MLAs:** The average assets of all MPs/MLAs (189) analyzed since 2004 is **Rs. 1.74 crores**.

CORRELATION BETWEEN CRIMINAL CASES AND FINANCIAL STATUS

Analysis of the data has revealed that money power and muscle power have a large bearing on the outcome of election result.

Average assets of MP/MLAs with criminal cases: The average assets of 104 MPs/MLAs (analyzed since 2004) with **criminal cases** is **Rs. 81.86 lakhs** and for 48 MPs/MLAs with **serious criminal charges** has been **Rs. 75.42 lakhs**.

PARTY WISE ANALYSIS OF ALL CANDIDATES ANALYZED SINCE 2004

Criminal

Party wise MPs/MLAs who have declared criminal cases: **55%** of MP/MLAs elected on **INC** tickets since 2004 have declared **criminal cases** against themselves (Out of 31 MPs/MLAs from INC, 17 have declared criminal cases). **40%** of MPs/MLAs elected on **BJP** tickets since 2004 have declared **criminal cases** against themselves (Out of 57 MPs/MLAs from BJP, 23 have declared criminal cases). **76%** of **JMM** MPs/MLAs have declared **criminal cases** (Out of 38 MPs/MLAs 29 have declared criminal cases).

Financial

Party wise average assets of candidates: The average assets of candidates who have contested on **INC** tickets since 2004 is **Rs. 1.99 Crores** and is the highest among all the parties analyzed. **BJP** candidates have an average asset of **51.49 lakhs**. **JMM** candidates had an average assets of **48.57 Lakhs** while **RJD** candidates had an average assets of **41.38 lakhs**.

Party wise average assets of MPs/MLAs: Since 2004, MPs/MLAs who have got elected on INC tickets have the highest average assets of Rs. 2.26 Crores followed by BJP MPs/MLAs with Rs. 64.77 Lakhs, JMM with average assets worth Rs. 55.56 lakhs and RJD with average assets worth Rs. 62.54 Lakhs. Independent MPs/MLAs have average assets of Rs. 8.87 crores. The table below provides a party wise analysis of candidates with declared criminal cases

CORRELATION BETWEEN CRIMINAL CASES DECLARED BY CANDIDATES AND THEIR CHANCES OF WINNING

- **Total candidates with clean records:** Out of 1761 contesting candidates analyzed since 2004, 1236 candidates have not declared any criminal cases, whereas 525 candidates declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Total MPs/MLAs with clean records:** Out of the 189 MPs/MLAs analyzed since 2004, there have been 85 MPs/MLAs who have not declared any criminal cases, whereas 104 MPs/MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Chances of winning election with clean record:** There is only 7% chance of winning election with a clean record. (Chances of winning with clean record = No. of winners with clean record divided by No. of candidates with clean record)
- **Chances of winning election with criminal records:** There is a 20% chance of winning an election for a candidate with criminal records. Moreover, there is an 18% chance of winning an election for a candidate with a serious criminal record. We see that the chances of winning for a candidate with criminal records is much higher than that for a candidate with a clean record.

CORRELATION BETWEEN EDUCATION AND CRIMINAL CASES

- **Candidates who are graduates (or above) and have declared criminal cases:** 706 out of 1761 candidates who have contested elections since 2004 (or 40% of the candidates analyzed) have a graduate degree or above. 231 or 33% of the candidates with graduate or above degrees have declared criminal cases. 112 or 16% of the candidates with graduate or above degrees have declared serious criminal charges.
- **Candidates who are 12th pass (or below) and have criminal cases:** 1055 out of 1761 candidates who have contested elections since 2004 (or 60% of the candidates analyzed) are 12th pass and below. 294 or 28% of the candidates who are 12th pass and below have declared criminal cases. 148 or 14% have declared serious charges.
- **MPs/MLAs who are graduates (or above) and have declared criminal cases:** 53 or 51% out of the 104 criminal MPs/MLAs have a graduate degree or above and 25 or 24% have declared serious charges.

- **MPs/MLAs who are 12th pass (or below) and have criminal cases:** 85 out of the total 189 MPs/MLAs who have contested elections since 2004 are 12th pass and below. 51 or 60% of the 85 MPs/MLAs who are 12th pass and below have declared criminal cases and 23 or 27% have declared serious criminal charges.

CORRELATION BETWEEN EDUCATION AND FINANCIAL STATUS

Average assets of candidates who are graduates and above: The average assets of candidates analyzed who have contested elections since 2004 with graduate or above degree is Rs. 67.87 Lakhs.

Average assets of candidates who are 12th Pass and below: The average assets of candidates analyzed who have contested elections since 2004, and are 12th Pass and below, are Rs. 31.78 Lakhs.

Analysis of graduate and Non-Graduate candidates with declared criminal cases

GENDER ANALYSIS

- **Women candidates:** Out of the 1761 candidates analyzed (who have contested elections since 2004), only 109 or 6% are women. Only 15 or 14% of the women candidates fielded have won whereas 174 or 11% of the men fielded have won.
- **Women candidates with criminal cases:** 21 or 19% of the 109 women candidates who have contested in elections since 2004 have declared criminal cases and 11 or 10% declared serious charges. 504 or 31% of the 1652 men candidates declared criminal cases and 249 or 15% declared serious criminal charges.

- **Women MLAs with criminal cases:** Only 1 of the 15 women MPs/MLAs (who have been elected in elections since 2004), have declared criminal case while 103 or 59% of the 174 MPs/MLAs, who are men, have declared criminal charges and 48 or 28% have declared serious criminal charges.
- **Average assets of Men/Women candidates:** The average assets of men candidates who have contested elections since 2004 is Rs. 47.86 Lakhs and the average asset of women candidates is Rs. 21.83 Lakhs.
