## **Criminal Background**

- <u>Candidates with Criminal Cases:</u> Out of 55 candidates analyzed, 7 (13%) candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- <u>Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:</u> 6(11%) candidates have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.
