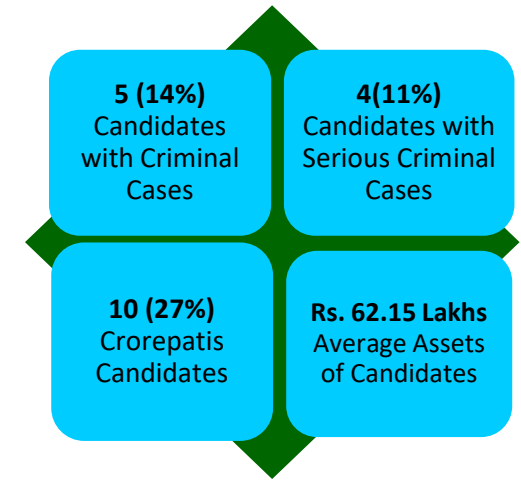

Criminal Background

- **Candidates with Criminal Cases:** Out of 37 candidates analyzed, **5 (14%)** candidates have declared criminal cases against themselves.

2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

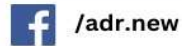
