Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Maharashtra Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of **8 winners** who have contested the **Maharashtra Legislative Council Biennial Elections of 2015**, from Local Authorities Constituencies. These 8 winners include **Mr. Vyas Girishchandra Bachharaj of BJP**, who has been elected unopposed from **Nagpur** Local Authority Constituency, even before the actual elections held on 27th December 2015.

Criminal Background

- **Winners with Criminal Cases:** Out of the **8** winners analysed, **6 (75%)** winners have declared criminal cases against them.
- **Winners with Serious Criminal Cases:** Out of the **8** winners, **2 (25%)** winners have declared serious criminal cases.
- **Party wise Winners with Criminal Cases:**
3 (100%) out of **3** winners analysed from **INC**, **1 (50%)** out of **2** winners analysed from **Shiv Sena**, **1 (100%)** out of **1** winner analysed from **NCP** and **1 (100%)** out of **1** winner analysed from **BJP** have declared **criminal cases** against themselves in their affidavits.
- **Party wise Winners with Serious Criminal Cases:** **1 (33%)** out of **3** winners analysed from **INC** and **1 (100%)** out of **1** winner analysed from **NCP** have declared **serious criminal cases** against themselves in their affidavits.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

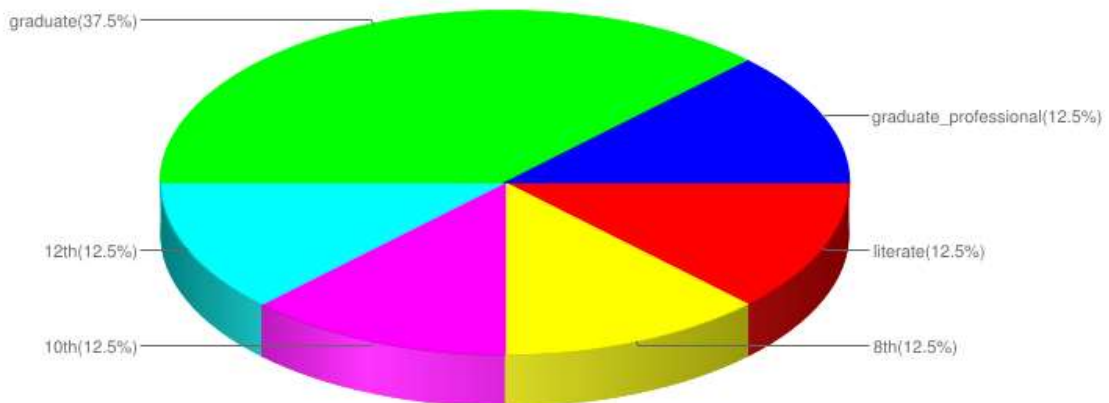
